





BUS PATROL-CALLS FOR SERVICE

The Transit Police Bus Patrol Dispatch Center received 1,050 requests for Transit Police service for the month of October 1995. "Calls for Service" for the Year-to-Date was approximately 13,925.

BUS PATROL CRIME REPORTS-OCTOBER 1995

The Transit Police Records Center has processed approximately 279 Bus Patrol reports for the month of October 1995. A total of 3,557 Bus Patrol reports have been processed Year-to-Date.

LOCATION OF REPORTED CRIME-OCTOBER 1995

A total of 115 reported incidents occurred on an identified Bus or Bus Line.
A total of 93 reported incidents occurred at a Bus Stop locations.
A total of 36 reported incidents occurred on MTA divisions/offices/or terminals.
A total of 35 reported incidents occurred on sidewalks, streets, or public areas.

BUS PATROL ARRESTS-OCTOBER 1995

There were a total of 186 arrests for this reporting period.
A total of 36 were for Adult Felony offenses.
A total of 117 were for Adult Misdemeanor offenses.
A total of 04 were for Juvenile Felony offenses.
A total of 29 were for Juvenile Misdemeanor offenses.


