INTRODUCTION

The Monthly Activity Report produced in partnership with the Los Angeles Police Department and the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department underwent changes in its crime reporting criteria effective January 2001. When compared to 2000 crime data, some numbers may reflect a major shift, making it appear that the crime trend has either increased or decreased by a large percentage. In particular, the reported crimes in PART 2 category, which are primarily the non-violent or less-violent crimes such as theft, fare evasion, and trespassing, were counted separately from vandalism. Since vandalism incidents in the transit system are now being monitored closely by LAPD and LASD, separate pages are now dedicated specifically to reflect vandalism trends throughout the transit system. There were also some minor changes made to the format of this report to show last year's crime level in comparison to this year's.

Starting with the January 2001 monthly report, an executive summary will be included which will identify trends and provide analysis. It will also describe recent law enforcement activities within the transit system that affect the reported crime numbers. Hopefully, this information will explain various significant increases or decreases in reported crime.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The purpose of this summary is to highlight any notable fluctuations in statistics when compared to previous reporting periods. Crime statistics that remain consistent will not be reflected in this summary.

There is a decrease in total citations for the Blue Line. The citation rate for fare enforcement violations remained consistent for December 2000 and January 2001. However, due to extremely inclement weather during the month of January, traffic enforcement citations decreased by 15%. A contributing factor is that motor officer deployment is reduced during rainy periods.

Although January figures represent an 11% decrease in citations along the bus routes, it is an 18% increase from the same period last year.

There is a downward trend for arrests along the bus routes. This decline is directly related to warrant arrests. In December 2000, TSB deputies made 29 non-warrant arrests. In January 2001, deputies made 28 non-warrant arrests. When a deputy makes a warrant arrest, it is usually a criminal charge from another jurisdiction. If those warrant arrests were removed from this equation, TSB arrest statistics would remain consistent.

The decrease in reported vandalism along the Green Line is a result of the Patrol Vandalism Team and detectives working extensively on the Green Line in the month of January. Many vandals have been identified and arrested. The decline in reported vandalism is a direct reflection of TSB enforcement efforts.

The Patrol Vandalism Team will continue to focus on the rail system. We anticipate a continued drop in reported vandalism incidents. Additionally, a second team for the bus system is being formed and will be deployed on March 3, 2001.

NOTE: There were 389 juvenile citations issued in this month.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During January 2001, the Redline ridership was estimated at 2,942,375. Transit Rail Division officers checked approximately 24% of the ridership (694,564) for fares, ultimately issuing 1,508 citations and 872 warnings for fare evasion violations. In addition, 88 arrests were made in connection with Redline stations and trains. Ninety nine arrests were made during the same period last year. Comparing last year to this year January numbers, serious crime remained the same at three occurrences. However, other crime (PART 2) jumped dramatically from only 12 occurrences in January 2000 to 70 occurrences in January 2001. The cause of this increase is due to the Los Angeles Police Department focusing heavily on identifying and arresting chronic fare evaders in the Redline system. In the past, these violators were issued personal service citations (a ticket) for each violation. However, if a violator is now identified as being a chronic fare evader (three or more citations within a year), a crime report is generated and entered into LAPD's crime database. If the violator is contacted again by a law enforcement officer and they are unable to provide proof of fare payment, rather than being issued another ticket, they are arrested and booked. The crime reports generated for the identified fare violators increased PART 2 crime numbers for this reporting period.

Citation productivity is up significantly when compared to the same period last year. During January 2001, Transit Rail Division officers issued 1590 total citations compared to 1379 for January 2000. This represents an increase of 15.3%.

There were 8 reported incidents of vandalism in the Redline system for January 2000, while same time period this year shows 23 incidents, an increase of 187.5%. This dramatic increase in reported vandalism is actually due to vandalism reports being captured more accurately than in prior months. Previously, when vandalism was discovered, a memo within MTA was often generated, rather than a crime report taken. Now, vandalisms are captured on crime reports and entered into the crime database, which has resulted in higher than normal reported incidents of vandalism in the transit system.

Reported serious crime in buses within the City has dropped from 87 occurrences in January 2000 to 65 occurrences in January 2001, a reduction of 25.3%. However, other crimes have increased for the same comparative period from 44 to 77, a 75% increase. This is primarily due to increase in reports of petty thefts and battery against bus patrons in buses or at the bus stops.

In January 2000, Transit Bus Division (TBD) officers initiated 183 arrests while in January 2001, they arrested 152 persons for a variety of offenses. However, total citations issued by TBD officer during this reporting period have increased dramatically. During January 2001, TBD issued 932 citations compared to only 475 citations from same period in 2000, an increase of 96.2%. Productivity level has increased overall by 62.3%, with TBD officers initiating 9,951 bus boardings this year compared to 6,129 bus boardings last year.

Reported incidents of vandalism have increased from 17 occurrences in January 2000 to 27 occurrences in January 2001, an increase of 58.8%. Again, this is reflective of the new vandalism reporting procedure within the Transit Group. To combat the incidents of vandalism within the bus system, TBD's Graffiti Habitual Offender Suppression Team (GHOST) undercover officers have been actively working the bus lines and bus stops to identify the persons responsible for the vandalisms. In recent weeks, GHOST officers have identified several individuals responsible for some of the incidents of vandalisms in buses.





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON









2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


Serious Crime Incidents (Part 1)







2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


Serious Crimes (Part 1)




