





EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,378,700. Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totalled 1600. Deputies checked approximately 27% (369,512) of the total ridership resulting in 803 fare related citations and 355 warnings. The majority of the citations, excluding photo enforcement citations, issued by TSB deputies were within the Imperial PAX reporting district followed by the Seventh/Metro Center/Julian Dixon Metro Rail Station.

Photo enforcement citations decreased by 39 citations when compared to last month. In addition to February being a short month, another contributing factor to this decrease is that some vehicles did not have a front license plate affixed. (This information was provided by a representative from Lockheed Martin). Nevertheless, photo enforcement citations increased by 89 citations when compared to February 2000.

There were 12 reported serious crimes this month. When compared to last month, serious crimes on the Blue Line increased by 2. In February 2000, there were 8 reported serious crimes. Motor vehicle theft increased by 5 in this reporting period when compared to last month. Other crimes (Part II), except for vandalism, decreased by 1 crime during this reporting period. In February 2000, there were 3 Part II crimes reported. This month the majority of Blue Line reported crimes occurred in Park-N-Ride lots, followed by reported crimes on the platforms.

Reported vandalism on the Blue Line decreased by 13 incidents when compared to last month. However, when compared to February 2000, reported vandalism incidents decreased by 4. The decline in reported vandalism is a direct reflection of TSB enforcement efforts.

TSB deputies assigned to the Blue Line made 55 arrests this month. This is a decrease of 16 arrests when compared to last month figures. This decline is primarily related to warrant arrests. Last month deputies made 45 warrant arrests and this month deputies made 31 warrant arrests. There were 24 non-warrant arrests made this month, compared to 26 non-warrant arrests made last month.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 607,900. Green Line citations totalled 461. Deputies checked approximately 25% (154,111) of the total ridership resulting in 383 fare related citations and 76 warnings. The majority of the citations issued by TSB deputies were within the Imperial/Wilmington PAX reporting district followed by the Crenshaw PAX reporting district.

There was one reported serious crime on the Green Line this month compared to 4 reported last month. In February 2000, there were also 4 reported serious crimes. Except for vandalism, there were no other crimes (Part II) reported on the Green Line this month. Last month there were 4 reported other crimes on the Green Line. In February of 2000, there were 3 reported other crimes.

Reported Vandalism decreased by 19 incidents this month when compared to last month, however when compared to February 2000, vandalism incidents increased by 22 incidents. As a reminder, this increase stems from the reporting process implemented in October 2000, by the MTA and LASD. Now, vandalism crimes are reported, tracked and processed in a comprehensive system, which includes LARCIS, MTA security notification, as well as the new reporting procedure for the Green Line.

TSB deputies assigned to the Green Line made a total of 36 arrests this month compared to 33 arrests made last month and exactly 33 arrests made in February of last year.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

Approximately 7,920,605 passengers patronized the buses patrolled by TSB deputies this month. There were 4,561 bus boardings by deputies this month. A total of 197 citations were issued by bus patrol. One citation was issued for fare evasion this month compared to 4 issued in February 2000.

There were 3 reported serious crimes on bus patrol this month. This is a decrease of 4 this month when compared to last month. When compared to February 2000, serious crimes on bus patrol decreased by 7. Other crimes (Part II), excluding vandalism, totalled 5 this reporting period compared to 7 other crimes that was reported last month. However, other crimes increased by 3 this month when compared to this same reporting period last year.

There were 4 reported vandalisms on bus patrol this month. Last month 3 incidents of vandalism were reported. In February 2000, there were 9 vandalism incidents reported.

Deputies made a total of 51 arrests this month compared to 41 last month. In February 2000, deputies made 35 arrests. There were 46 adults and 5 juveniles arrested this month compared to 38 adults and 3 juveniles arrested last month.

NOTE: There were 324 juvenile citations issued by TSB deputies in the month of February 2001.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During February 2001, the Red Line ridership was estimated at 2,842,300 as compared to January's estimated number of 2,942,375. That represents a decrease of 3.4% in ridership, most likely due to the short month. Transit Rail Division's policing activity also decreased slightly for the same reason. Compiled data for TRD's activity showed a slight decrease from last month's activities, with TRD officers conducting 644,207 random fare checks and issuing 856 warnings for fare violations, as compared to 694,564 fare checks and 872 fare warnings in January 2001. That represents a decrease of 7.25% for fare checks and 1.83% for fare warnings.

Transit Rail Division officers made 109 arrests in February compared to 88 in the previous month, an increase of 23.86%. The marked increase in arrests is due to the number of fare evasion arrests made by the TRD officers. In January, 22 fare violators were arrested. In February, 30 violators were arrested for fare evasion. Officers are conducting more thorough check of violators during their random fare checks. When a violator is contacted, they are checked against the "chronic fare violator" list to see if they were issued a citation for the same offense before. This has also resulted in more violators being arrested for outstanding warrants. In January 2001, 19 violators were taken into custody for court issued arrest warrants. That number increased to 30 in February.

Serious crime in the Red Line System is still very low, staying the same at 3 occurrences as in the prior month. There were 8 serious crime occurrences in February 2000. That is a decrease of 62.5% in serious crimes from one year ago. However, when comparing the data for "OTHER CRIMES" from February 2000 to February 2001, the number jumped significantly from 10 to 78. There are several reasons for this increase in "OTHER CRIMES." Transit Rail Division started identifying chronic fare violators in January 2001 from the citation database and started writing crime reports when violators were identified as having been issued three or more citations within a one year time period. Those crime reports increased the "OTHER CRIME" numbers significantly from last year's total. Also, Transit Services Section Crime Analysis Unit is tracking more incidents such as lost property and narcotic violations within the Red Line System to see if there is a pattern. Those numbers included with fare evasion crime reports increased the "OTHER CRIME" numbers.

February 2001 citation activity showed a slight decrease from January 2001, however, this can also be attributed to the decrease in the ridership and the 28 day month. In February, TRD officers issued 1,472 citations, of which 1,416 were fare related. Last month citation activity showed 1,590 total citations. Although last month's fare evasion citation total is higher, when it is analyzed and broken down by 31 days in January versus 28 days in February, the February citation activity per day was higher at 50.57 cites per day versus 48.64 cites per day in January. When compared to February 2000 (1,347 fare related citations), this month's fare related citations shows an increase of 5.12%.

Vandalism in the Red Line System stayed fairly consistent, at 23 this month compared to 20 last month.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

The February 2001 total reported crimes in buses and at bus stops totaled 148 incidents compared to 142 incidents in January 2001. Serious crime incidents within those numbers increased from 65 incidents in January to 73 incidents in February, an increase of 12.31%. In particular, the increase was due to robberies at bus stops. In January, there were 38 transit-related robbery incidents captured in the LAPD crime database which increased to 47 in February. However, the overall serious crime in buses and at bus stops decreased by 10.98% when comparing the yearly trend. The February 2000 serious crime incidents totaled 82 versus the current figure of 73.

Transit Bus Division officers initiated 122 arrests this month, compared to 152 arrests last month, a decrease of 19.74%. Some of this decrease can be attributed to the short month. However, when compared to February 2000, it showed a marked decrease in arrests. February 2000 showed 199 arrests, as compared to 122 this month, a decrease of 38.69%. This decrease is, however, offset by the significant increase in citation activity. February 2001 total citation was 1,483 compared to 486 from a year ago, an increase of 205.14%. Transit Bus Division officers are focusing more on transit safety, conducting bus lane traffic enforcement and traffic hazard enforcement around bus routes and buses rather than arrests.

Productivity level has increased overall by 42.35%, with TBD officers initiating 9,273 bus boardings this year compared to 6,514 bus boardings last year.

There were 22 incidents of vandalism in February 2001 and 18 incidents a year ago same time period, which is an increase of 22.22%. However, when comparing last month to this month, overall vandalism incidents went down, from 27 to 22, a decrease of 18.52%.



2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


Serious Crimes (Part 1)






