EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,720,525, compared to 1,378,700 last month and 1,594,450 in March 2000. Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2412 this month compared to 1600 last month and 2206 in March 2000. Deputies checked approximately 22% (377,913) of the total ridership. This is an increase of 8,401 additional fare checks when compared to last month. Of the total ridership, 1,142 fare related citations were written. This is a 30% (339) increase in the number of fare related citations written this month compared to last month. Even though deputies made fewer fare checks this month (377,913) than March 2000 (400,471), there were 270 more fare related citations issued this month than in March 2000.

Deputies gave 92 more fare warnings this month (447) than last month (355), however, fare warnings declined by 1,199 when compared to March 2000 (1,646). The majority of the citations, excluding photo enforcement, issued by TSB deputies were within the Seventh/Metro Center/Julian Dixon Metro Rail Station, followed by the Grand PAX reporting district.

There were 9 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported this month. This is a decrease of 3 compared to last month and a decrease of 8 when compared to this same reporting period last year. Other Crimes (Part II), except vandalism, increased by 7 this reporting period when compared to last month. Specifically, incidents of battery increased by 5 this month alone compared to last month. Four of these incidents were committed against peace officers as they attempted to remove/restrain disruptive patrons.

There were 12 reported vandalisms this month. This is an increase of 1 compared to last month. This month most of the reported vandalisms were done to trains, bike lockers and ticket vending machines.

Deputies assigned to the Blue Line initiated 92 arrests. This month's arrest total is an increase of 37 when compared to last month. However, when compared to this same reporting period last year, deputies made 5 fewer arrests. There were 88 adults and 4 juveniles arrested this month. Again, warrant arrests are contributing factors to this increase. This reporting period deputies made 51 warrant arrests; last reporting period deputies made 31 warrant arrests. In this same reporting period last year, deputies made

55 warrant arrests. Narcotic violations are another contributing factor for the increase in arrests this reporting period. Last month there were 6 suspects arrested for narcotics. This reporting period, there were 14 suspects arrested for narcotic violations.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 711,825. This is an increase of 103,925 compared to last month (607,900). There were 492 citations issued this month compared to 461 issued last month and 464 issued this same period last year. Deputies assigned to the Green Line checked 25% (180,566) of the ridership this month. This is 15% (26,455) more fare checks than last month (154,111) and 83,800 more fare checks than March 2000 (96,766). A total of 196 fare warnings were given this month, this is 61% (120) more fare warnings than last month (76). During this same reporting period last year, 335 fare warnings were given.

There were 6 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within the Green Line jurisdiction this month. This is an increase of 5 when compared to last month. Vehicle thefts and vehicle burglaries accounts for all Serious Crimes this month. Although Serious Crimes increased this month, it is 5 fewer Serious Crimes than this same reporting period last year.

Other Crimes (Part II), except vandalism, increased by 3 this reporting period. Last month there was no reported Other Crime and last year during this same reporting period, there was no reported Other Crime.

There were 34 reported vandalisms this month. This is 9 more vandalism incidents reported than last month and 23 more reported incidents than March 2000. Again, the newly implemented vandalism reporting procedure allows for more vandalism incidents to be properly reported, documented, and investigated.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line made 22 arrests during this reporting period. This is 14 fewer arrests than last month and 7 more arrests than March 2000. Public awareness and high visibility of uniform personnel are contributors to this reduction in arrests this month.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

Approximately 9,016,715 passengers patronized the buses patrolled by TSB deputies this month. This is an increase of 1,063,720 compared to last month (7,952,995). In March 2000, there were approximately 8,484,423 passengers. There were 5,949 bus boardings by deputies this month. This is an increase of 1,388 when compared to last month (4,561). The new satellite office established in El Monte, combined with highly motivated deputies, are direct contributions to this month's increase in bus boardings.

There were 207 citations issued by bus patrol this month. Deputies issued 3 fare related citations this month, compared to 1 issued last month and 5 issued in March 2000.

There were 7 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported this month. This is an increase of 4 when compared to last month however, when compared to this same reporting period last year, Serious Crimes declined by 16. Other crimes (Part II), excluding vandalism, totaled 7 this reporting period compared to 5 last reporting period.

There were 9 reported vandalisms this month. This is an increase of 5 incidents this month compared to last month. This increase is a direct reflection of the new vandalism team created specifically for bus patrol. Once vandalism incidents are identified, this team photographs the damages and completes the appropriate crime report, which is then entered into our computer databases for tracking and investigative purposes.

Deputies assigned to bus patrol made 68 arrests this month compared to 51 last month.

NOTE: There were 368 juvenile citations issued this month.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

Metro Red Line System and Transit Rail Division (TRD) were active in March. Red Line ridership was estimated at 3,150,975 as compared to February's estimated number of 2,842,300, an increase of 10.86%. TRD officers conducted 892,776 random fare checks which is approximately 28% of the total ridership. When comparing this month's fare check against last month's fare check, officers' fare check productivity increased 38.59% (Last month's fare check was 644,207.) Compiled data for TRD's activity showed a decrease for fare warnings from 856 last month to 703 this month, a decrease of 17.87%. However, citations and arrests increased from previous month. A total of 1,527 citations were issued to violators in March as compared to 1,472 citations issued last month, an increase of 3.74%. Arrests in and around the Red Line System increased by 8.26% (March arrests totaled 118; February total was 109.)

Serious crime in the Red Line System remained low. Los Angeles Police Department, Transit Group, received four reports of serious crime during March. There were only three reported serious crimes in February. PART 2 "other crimes" dropped from 78 incidents in February to 54 in March, a decrease of 30.77%. Although officers issued more citations and contacted more patrons during the fare checks, most chronic fare violators have already been identified and crimes reports have been generated.

Vandalism incidents were reported at 23, up from 20 from last month, an increase of 15%.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

The March 2001 total reported crimes in buses and at bus stops totaled 214 incidents compared to 148 incidents in February 2001, an alarming increase of 44.59%. However, the serious crime incidents within those numbers increased from 73 incidents in February to 77 in March, a modest increase of only 5.48%. The increase in total number of crime incidents was due to increase in

reports of battery on transit patrons, lost property, and threats. There were 47 robberies last month and 52 reported this month.

Transit Bus Division officers initiated 134 arrests this month, compared to 122 arrests last month, an increase of 9.84%. Some of this increase is due to more vandalism arrests and arrest cite-outs. When compared to March of last year, there is a drop of 36.49% from a total of 211 arrests. However, this decrease is offset by the significant increase in citation activity. March 2001 citation total was 1,459 compared to 435 from a year ago, an increase of 235.40%

Bus boarding increased significantly also, from 9,273 in February to 10,112 in March, a 9.05% increase. A year ago, Transit Bus Division officers initiated 6,432 bus boardings, or a yearly comparison increase in productivity of 57.21%.

Vandalism incidents increased slightly from 22 to 29 incidents from February to March 2001.





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON




