EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line this month was estimated at 1,654,750, compared to 1,720,525 last month. Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2584 compared to last months citations which totaled 2412. Deputies checked approximately 17% or 278,724 passengers of the total ridership. This is a decrease of 99,189 farechecks when compared to 377, 913 conducted last month. Of the total ridership, 1,350 fare related citations were issued, which is an increase of 208 more fare-related citations issued this month than last month.

This month deputies issued 276 fare warnings. This is a decrease of 171 fewer fare warnings than the 447 warnings issued last month. During this reporting period, citations increased and fare warnings decreased.

Eight Part I Crimes occurred within the Blue Line jurisdiction this month. This is a slight decrease of (1) less Part I Crime than last month. Except for vandalism, Part II crimes dropped to (2) from the (9) reported last month, and those two were only petty thefts.

There were 15 reports of vandalism reported this month which reflects an increase of 3 over last month. Most of the vandalism was restricted to the interior of the trains, elevators and stairs.

Deputies arrested 90 adults and 8 juveniles on the Blue Line this month. This is an increase of 6 more arrests than last month.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 724,950 compared to 711,825 last month. Deputies assigned to the Green Line checked 25% of the total ridership or 178,740 passengers. They issued 870 citations this month compared to 492 last month. Deputies conducted saturation directed patrol, resulting in an additional 378 citations written this month. Fare-relation citations increased this month to 745 when compared to last month's total of 343. Deputies issued 260 fare warnings this month, which is an

increase of 64 fare warnings over last month.

There were 9 Part I Crimes reported within the Green Line jurisdiction this month. This is an increase of 3 when compared to last month. Vehicle thefts and vehicle burglaries accounted for 7 of the 9 Part I Crimes reported this month.

With the exception of vandalism, 4 Part II Crimes, were reported this month. This is only an increase of 1 when compared to last month's figures and "Battery against a peace officer" accounted for 3 of the 4 reported crimes.

This month there were 30 reports of vandalism. This is a decrease of 4 when compared to last month. Deputies assigned to the Green Line initiated 31 arrests this month; this is 9 more arrests than last month. There were 29 adults and 2 juveniles arrested during this reporting period.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

Approximately 8,634,514 passengers patronized the buses patrolled by TSB deputies this month, compared to 9,016,715 last month. There were 5,716 bus boardings conducted by deputies this month. This is a slight decline (less than 5%) exactly 233 fewer bus boardings conducted this month when compared to last month.

There were 205 citations issued by bus patrol this month. Of the total citations issued, 1 was for fare evasion.

There were 6 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported this month, this is a decrease of 1 when compared to Serious Crimes reported last month. Other Crimes (Part II), excluding vandalism, totaled 10 this reporting period compared to 7 last reporting period.

Reported vandalisms skyrocketed this month. A total of 31 were reported this month compared to 9 reported last month. This increase is a direct reflection of the effectiveness of the Bus Patrol Vandalism Team, the reporting process recently implemented by the MTA and LASD where all reported vandalism crimes are tracked and processed in a comprehensive system, which includes LARCIS & MTA Security notification.

Deputies assigned to bus patrol made 57 arrests this month compared to 68 last month.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 609 juvenile citations during this reporting period.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

In the month of April, Red Line ridership was estimated at 3,170,675 compared to March estimated number of 3,150,975, an increase of only 0.63%. TRD officers conducted 719,455 random fare checks which is approximately 23% of the total ridership. When comparing this month's fare check against last month's fare check, officers' fare check productivity decreased by 19.41% (Last month's fare check was 892,776.) Compiled data for TRD's activity showed a decrease for fare warnings from 703 last month to 633 this month, a decrease of 9.96%. Citations and arrests also decreased from previous month. A total of 1,358 citations were issued to violators in April as compared to 1,527 citations issued last month, a decrease of 11.07%. Arrests in and around the Red Line System decreased by 37.29% (April arrests totaled 74; March total was 118.)

Serious crime in the Red Line System still continues to remain low. Transit Rail Division received three reports of serious crime during April. There were four reported serious crimes in March. PART 2 "Other Crimes" dropped from 54 incidents in March, to 27 in April, a decrease of 50%.

Vandalism incidents were reported at 15, down from 23 for the previous month, a decrease of 34.78%.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

The April 2001 total reported crimes in buses and at bus stops totaled 158 incidents compared to 214 incidents in March 2001, a decrease of 26.17%. Serious crime incidents within those numbers also decreased from 77 incidents in March, to 72 in April. The unusually high number of incidents in March does not seem to fall within the "normal" range and does not indicate any particular trend in the increase of crime on the bus system. April data showed that the activity in the bus system fell within the expected range. There were 52 robberies last month and 43 reported this month.

Transit Bus Division officers initiated 167 arrests this month, compared to 134 arrests last month, an increase of 24.63%. April 2001 citation total was 1,050 compared to 1,459 from last month.

Bus boardings decreased also from 10,112 in March to 7,873 in April, a 22.14% decrease. A year ago, Transit Bus Division officers initiated 7,449 bus boardings.

Although reported vandalism incidents increased from 29 in March, to 35 incidents in April 2001, it is believed that the vast majority of vandalisms associated with bus operations are still not reported to the Police Department. It is essential that Bus Operations Management and the Police Department work together to resolve this inequity. It is estimated that the true number of vandalisms occurring on buses may be as high as from 2 to 4 thousand occurrences each month.



2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON




Serious Crimes (Part 1)




