EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

During the month of May, ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,747,025 compared to 1,654,750 last month. Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,359 this month compared to 2,584 last month. Deputies checked 17% of the total ridership or 303,236 passengers. This is an increase of 24,512 farechecks when compared to last month. Deputies assigned to the Blue Line issued 1,101 citations for fare-related violations.

This month deputies issued 262 fare warnings. This is 14 fewer fare warnings than the 276 warnings issued last month.

Twelve Part I Crimes occurred within the Blue Line jurisdiction this month. This is an increase of 4 Part I Crimes when compared to last month (8). The additional Part I Crimes reported were assaults and vehicle thefts.

With the exception of vandalism, Part II Crimes increased to 7 from the 2 reported last month. Misdemeanor batteries accounts for the increase in reported Part II Crimes.

There were 10 reports of vandalism reported this month which reflects a decrease of 5 in comparison to last month. Most of the vandalism was restricted to the interior of the trains, TVMs, and MTA signs.

Deputies assigned to the Blue Line arrested 62 adults and 6 juveniles this month. This is a decrease of 30 when compared to the 98 arrests made last month.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 802,350 compared to 724,950 last month. Deputies assigned to the Green Line checked 28% of the total ridership or 222,659 passengers.

A total of 690 citations were issued this month compared to 870 issued last month. Of the total citations issued this month, 554 were for fare-related violations compared to the 745 fare-related citations issued last month. Exactly 100 fewer fare warnings was issued this month compared to the 260 issued last month.

There were 9 Part I Crimes reported within the Green Line jurisdiction this month which is exactly the same number reported last month.

With the exception of vandalism, 8 Part II Crimes, were reported this month. This is an increase of 4 when compared to last month's figures. The 4 additional Part II Crimes reported this month included batteries, petty theft, and a sex offense.

This month there were 21 reports of vandalism. This is a decrease of 9 when compared to last month.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 25 adults and 3 juveniles during this reporting period.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

Approximately 8,997,583 passengers patronized the buses patrolled by TSB deputies this month, compared to 8,634,514 last month. There were 6,536 bus boardings conducted by deputies this month. This is an increase of 820 when compared to the 5,716 bus boardings conducted last month.

There were 343 citations issued by bus patrol this month; this is an increase of 138 when compared to last month. Of the total citations issued this month, 7 was for fare-related violations.

Five Serious Crimes (Part I) were reported this month. This is exactly the same number reported last month. Other Crimes (Part II), excluding vandalism, totaled 8 this reporting period compared to 11 reported last month.

There were 9 reported vandalisms within Bus Patrol jurisdiction this month compared to 31 reported last month.

The drop in vandalism crimes is primarily due to a new procedure where we have restructured our reporting districts as it relates to vandalism. Since it is often unknown whether the crime of vandalism occurs in the City of Los Angeles or the County of Los Angeles, we have implemented a new "non-specific" reporting district. These non-specific reporting districts are used when a

report is written and the location of the violation is not known. Due to the Sheriff's Department not knowing whether these crimes occur, they are not incorporated into our statistics until such time as the case is investigated and jurisdiction is determined.

Deputies assigned to bus patrol arrested 57 adults and 13 juveniles. This calculates to 13 more arrests than the 57 arrests reported last month.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 481 juvenile citations during this reporting period.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

In the month of May, Red Line ridership was estimated at 3,549,400 compared to April's estimated number of 3,170,675, a leap of 11.9%. TRD officers conducted 518,701 random fare checks which is approximately 15% of the total ridership. When comparing this month's fare check against last month's fare check, officers' fare check productivity decreased by 28% (Last month's fare check was 719,455). This is a significant decrease for the second month in a row. Compiled data for TRD's activity showed an increase of 117% for fare warnings from 633 last month to 1375 this month. Citations and arrests also increased from previous month. A total of 1,404 citations were issued to violators in May as compared to 1,358 citations issued in April, an increase of 3.4%. Of these 1,404 citations, 1,296 were issued for fare evasion (92%). Arrests in and around the Red Line System increased by 73% (May arrests totaled 128; April total was 74).

Crime in the Redline System has rebounded from April's low numbers. Transit Rail Division received seven reports of serious crime during May. There were three reported serious crimes in April, four in March. PART 2 "Other Crimes" were 44 in May, up 63% from 27 in April, but down 19% from 54 incidents in March. This year's monthly average is 55.

Vandalism incidents were reported at 19 in May, up from 15 for April, an increase of 27%.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

The May 2001 total reported crimes in buses and at bus stops totaled 165 incidents compared to 158 incidents in April 2001, an increase of 4.4%. Serious crime incidents within those numbers also increased from 72 incidents in April, to 79 in May. May data showed that most activity in the bus system fell within the expected range, up 3% from April due to May having 31 days vs April's 30 days. There were 43 robberies last month and 47 reported this month.

Transit Bus Division officers initiated 114 arrests in May (compared to 167 arrests in April), the lowest monthly total so far this year. May's citations total of 1,073 and April's citations total of 1,050 were down from a high of 1,483 in February and 1,459 in March.

Bus boardings increased 4.2% from 7,873 in April to 8,202 in May. However, the average per day shows no significant change (May - 264 vs April - 262).

Although reported vandalism incidents decreased from 35 in April, to 29 incidents in May 2001 (this year's monthly average is 28), it is believed that the vast majority of vandalisms associated with bus operations are still not reported to the Police Department. It is essential that Bus Operations Management and the Police Department work together to resolve this inequity. It is estimated that the true number of vandalisms occurring on buses may be as high as from 2 to 4 thousand occurrences each month.





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


Serious Crimes (Part 1)



Other Crime Incidents (Part 2)








2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


