

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

During the month of June, ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,708,700 compared to 1,747,025 last month. Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,059 this month compared to 2,359 last month. This month deputies checked 19% of the total ridership or 324,311 passengers. This is an increase of 21,075 farechecks when compared to last month (303,236). Deputies assigned to the Blue Line issued 874 citations for fare-related violations this month compared to 1,101 issued last month.

Fare warnings issued this month (253) decreased by 9 when compared to last month (262).

There were 8 Part I Crimes reported this month. Last month 12 Part I Crimes were reported.

With the exception of vandalism, Part II Crimes increased by 5 this month compared to the 7 reported last month. Petty Thefts accounts for the increase in the additional Part II crimes that were reported.

This month 10 incidents of vandalism was reported; last month there were also 10 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Blue Line arrested 64 adults and 6 juveniles this month. Last month deputies made 68 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 764,300 this month compared to 802,350 last month. Deputies assigned to the Green Line checked 27% of the total ridership or 206,363 passengers.

A total of 594 citations were issued this month compared to 690 issued last month. Of the total citations issued this month, 470 were for fare-related violations compared to the 554 fare-related citations issued last month.

Green Line deputies issued 178 fare warnings during this reporting period; compared to 160 fare warnings issued last month.

There were 22 Part I Crimes reported within the Green Line jurisdiction this month. Last month there were 9 Part I Crimes reported. The 13 additional Part I Crimes that were reported included 9 Robberies and 4 Vehicle Burglaries. Surveillance teams along with extra deputies were deployed and suspects were taken into custody.

With the exception of vandalism, 6 Part II Crimes, were reported this month. This is an decrease of 2 when compared to the 8 reported last month.

This month there were 7 incidents of vandalism reported. This is a decrease of 14 when compared to last month (21).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 28 adults and 2 juveniles during this reporting period. Last month Green Line deputies made 28 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

Approximately 8,349,434 passengers patronized the buses patrolled by TSB deputies this month. This is 648,149 fewer passenger than last month (8,997,583).

Deputies conducted 7,913 bus boardings this month. This is an increase of 1,377 when compared to the 6,536 bus boardings conducted last month.

There were 264 citations issued by bus patrol this month; this is a decrease of 79 when compared to the 343 citations issued last month. Of the total citations issued this month, 3 were for fare evasion.

During this reporting period there were 5 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported. This is the exact number of Serious Crimes reported last month. With the exception of vandalism, Other Crimes (Part II) reported this month totaled 9 compared to 8 reported last month.

There were 8 reported vandalisms within Bus Patrol jurisdiction this month compared to 9 reported last month.

Deputies assigned to bus patrol arrested 68 adults and 6 juveniles; this calculates to 4 more arrests this month than last month (70).

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 380 juvenile citations during this reporting period.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During the month of June, Red Line ridership was estimated at 3,822,675 compared to May's estimated number of 3,549,400, another leap of 7.7%. Ridership has shown an uptrend starting March this year. TRD officers conducted 693,128 random fare checks which is approximately 18% of the total ridership. This month's fare check of 693,128 increased officers' fare check productivity by 34% (May's fare check was 518,701). The 117% jump for fare warnings from April to May settled back to a normal 711 fare checks (633 in April, 1375 in May). Citations and arrests also increased from previous month. A total of 1,670 citations were issued to violators in June as compared to 1,404 citations issued in May, an increase of 19%. Of these 1,670 citations, 1,501 were issued for fare evasion (90%). Arrests in and around the Red Line System increased by 37% (June arrests totaled 175; May total was 128). CAD has made an adjustment in reporting Transit Group misdemeanor arrests, to standardize with existing LAPD and Geographical Division policy and procedures. This adjustment will ensure a more accurate reflection of misdemeanor arrests made by officers.

Crime in the Redline System has continued to be significantly higher than the low figures reported earlier in the year. Transit Rail Division received eight reports of serious crime in June. There were seven reported serious crimes in May, compared to three in April, four in March. PART 2 "Other Crimes" were 30 in June, down 32% from 44 in May. CAD has again adjusted its reporting procedures for crime in order to maximize accuracy. Until June, Lost/Found Property reports were included in Part 2 crime totals, resulting in an inflated number.

Vandalism incidents were reported at 10 in June, down from a high of 19 in May, decreasing by almost half.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

The June 2001 total reported crimes (not including vandalism) in buses and at bus stops totaled 173 incidents compared to 165 incidents in May 2001, a 4.8% increase. Part I Crimes fell 25%, from 79 incidents in May, to 59 in June. There were 47 robberies in May and 40 reported in June, a 15% decrease.

Transit Bus Division officers initiated 126 arrests in June (edging up from 114 arrests in May). June citations total of 1,168 shows a recovery from May's total of 1,073, but still several hundred short from totals earlier in the year (1,483 in February and 1,459 in March).

Bus boardings remained constant, totalling 8,165 in June (8,202 in May), actually achieving a higher daily average (272-June vs. 265-May).

Although reported vandalism incidents decreased from 29 in May, to 24 incidents in June (this year's monthly average is 28), it is believed that the vast majority of vandalisms associated with bus operations are still not reported to the Police Department. It is essential that Bus Operations Management and the Police Department work together to resolve this inequity. It is estimated that the true number of vandalisms occurring on buses may be as high as from 2 to 4 thousand occurrences each month.



2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON



2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


