EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

During the month of July, ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,778,475 compared to 1,708,700 in June.

Blue Line citations totaled 1655; last month citations totaled 1,872. This is a decrease of 217 citations.

This month deputies checked 18% of the total ridership or 321,126 passengers. Deputies assigned to the Blue Line issued 729 citations for fare-related violations this month. This calculates to 145 fewer citations when compared to the 874 issued in June.

Deputies issued 67 more fare warnings this month (320) than last month (253).

During this reporting period, 10 Part I Crimes were reported. This is 2 more reported crimes than last month (8).

With the exception of vandalism, Part II Crimes decreased by 5 in July, compared to the 12 reported last month.

This month 11 incidents of vandalism were reported; this is an increase of 1 when compared to the 10 reported last month.

Deputies assigned to the Blue Line arrested 50 adults and 4 juveniles. This is 16 fewer arrests this month than last month (70).

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 769,500 in July, compared to 764,300 last month. Deputies assigned to the Green Line checked 22% of the total ridership or 171,099 passengers. This is 35,264 fewer fare checks than last month.

A total of 459 citations were issued this month compared to 594 issued last month. Of the total citations issued this month, 325 were for fare-related violations compared to the 470 fare-related citations issued last month.

Green Line deputies issued 176 fare warnings during this reporting period. Last month 178 fare warnings were issued.

A total of 9 Part I Crimes reported within the Green Line jurisdiction this month. Last month there were 22 Part I Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 5 Part II Crimes were reported this month. Last month there were 6 Part II Crimes reported.

Thirteen incidents of vandalism was reported this month. This is an increase of 3 incidents than what was reported last month (10).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 22 adults and 5 juveniles during this reporting period. Last month Green Line deputies made 30 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

Approximately 9,070,810 passengers patronized the buses patrolled by TSB deputies this month. In June, 8,349,434 passengers patronized the buses.

Deputies conducted 6,999 bus boardings this month. This is a decrease of 914 when compared to the 7,913 bus boardings conducted last month.

There were 416 citations issued by bus patrol this month; this is an increase of 152 when compared to the 264 citations issued last month. Of the total citations issued this month, 3 were for fare-related violations.

During this reporting period there were 10 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported. Last month 5 Serious Crimes were reported. The 5 additional Serious Crimes that were reported this month included 2 robberies, an assault, a vehicle burglary and a grand theft.

There were 12 incidents of vandalism reported within Bus Patrol's jurisdiction this month compared to 8 reported last month.

Deputies arrested 74 adults and 11 juveniles during this reporting period. This calculates to 11 more arrests this month than last month (74).

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line, and Bus Patrol issued a total of 344 juvenile citations during this reporting period.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During the month of July, Red Line ridership was estimated at 3,810,325 compared to June's estimated number of 3,822,675, down by 0.3%. TRD officers conducted 881,420 random fare checks which is approximately 23% of the total ridership. This month's fare check increased officers' fare check productivity by 27% (June's fare check was 693,128). July's 1044 fare warnings were up 47% from 711 warnings in June. Citations remained constant - 1667 citations issued in July vs 1670 issued to violators in June. Of these 1,667 citations, 1,545 were issued for fare evasion (93%). Arrests in and around the Red Line System decreased by 70% (July arrests totaled 53, significantly down from June's 175 arrests).

Crime in the Redline System has decreased slightly from the recent upward trend over the past few months. Transit Rail Division received six reports of serious crime in July. There were eight reported serious crimes in June, compared to seven in May. There were 14 PART 2 "Other Crimes" in July, down 53% from 30 in June. CAD has once again adjusted its reporting procedures for crime in order to maximize accuracy. In future reports, Vandalism & Fare Evasion arrests will be included in reported crime statistic totals.

Vandalism incidents were reported at 4 in July, down from 10 in June, vastly under-reported.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

July 2001's estimated bus ridership of 23,324,941 increased by 8.6% from June's estimated 21,469,252.

The July 2001 total reported crimes (not including vandalism) in buses and at bus stops totaled 146 incidents compared to 173 incidents in June 2001, a 16% decrease. Part I Crimes increased 42%, from 59 incidents in June, to 84 in July. There were 40 robberies in June and 60 reported in July, a 50% increase.

Transit Bus Division officers initiated 142 arrests in July (up 13% from 126 arrests in June). July citations total of 989 is down 18% from June citations (1168). This is the lowest total since January 2001. The 2001 average is 1135.

Bus boardings remained constant, totalling 8,303 in July (8,165 in June). The 2001 average is 8,840.

Although reported vandalism incidents decreased from 24 in June, to 16 incidents in July (this year's monthly average is 26), it is believed that the vast majority of vandalisms associated with bus operations are **still** not reported to the Police Department. It is essential that Bus Operations Management and the Police Department work together to resolve this inequity. It is estimated that the true number of vandalisms occurring on buses may be as high as from 2 to 4 thousand occurrences each month. Future reports will include Vandalism arrests in reported Vandalism statistics.

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON




Serious Crimes (Part 1)




