EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,569,225 during the month of September. In August, ridership was estimated at 1,929,300.

During the month of September, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 27% of the total ridership or 423,383 passengers. In August, deputies inspected 21% or 407,117 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,035. This is an increase of 99 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (1,936).

Blue Line deputies issued 810 fare-related citations, this is an increase of 53 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in August (757).

Fare warnings increased during this reporting period (183) when compared to the last reporting period (173).

During September, 10 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported. This is a decrease of 2 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in August (12).

With the exception of vandalism, Part II Crimes (Other Crimes) also decrease by 2 during this reporting period compared to the 10 reported last month.

Four fewer incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of September (10). In August, 14 incidents of vandalism were reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 57 adults and 9 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 61 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of September, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 717,075 ridership for the month of August was estimated at 782,000.

Green Line deputies inspected 14% of the total ridership or 102,969 passengers. During the month of August, deputies inspected 17% of the total ridership or 136,230 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in September is a decrease of 33,261 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in August.

Green Line deputies issued 237 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 286 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of September, 144 were for fare-related violations; in August, 195 fare-related citations were issued.

Seventy-four fewer fare warnings were issued this month (39) when compared to the 113 issued last month.

There were 12 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of September. This is a decline of 10 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in August (22).

With the exception of vandalism, 5 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 7 Other Crimes were reported.

There were 12 incidents of vandalism reported in September. This is the exact number of vandalism incidents reported during the month of August.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 6 adults and 4 juveniles during the month of September. In August, deputies made a total of 19 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of September approximately 7,887,966 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In August, approximately 9,515,008 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 7,392 bus boardings this month. This is an increase of 72 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (7,320).

During the month of September, deputies issued a total of 273 citations; in August, 239 citations were issued.

There were 5 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of September; during the month of August, there were no Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 11 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of September. In August, 7 Other Crimes were reported.

Two incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is a decrease of 12 when compared to the incidents reported last month (14).

Deputies arrested 48 adults and 6 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 58 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 289 juvenile citations during the month of September.



2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON




2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON
