#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

##### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,669,350 during the month of October. In September, ridership was estimated at 1,569,225.

During the month of October, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 27% of the total ridership or 457,835 passengers. In September, deputies also inspected 27% or 423,383 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,826. This is an increase of 791 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,035).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,456 fare-related citations, this is an increase of 646 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in September (810).

Fare warnings increased during this reporting period (490) when compared to the last reporting period (183).

During October, 13 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported. This is an increase of 3 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in September (10).

With the exception of vandalism, Part II Crimes (Other Crimes) decreased by 1 during this reporting period compared to the 8 reported last month.

Three fewer incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of October (11). In September, 14 incidents of vandalism were reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 66 adults and 16 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 66 arrests.

### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of October, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 892,900. Ridership for the month of September was estimated at 717,075.

Green Line deputies inspected 14% of the total ridership or 123,095 passengers. During the month of September, deputies also inspected 14% of the total ridership or 102,969 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in October is an increase of 20,126 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in September.

Green Line deputies issued 331 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 237 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of October, 246 were for fare-related violations; in September, 144 fare-related citations were issued.

Sixty-eight more fare warnings were issued this month (107) when compared to the 39 issued last month.

There were 13 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of October. This is an increase of 1 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in September (12).

With the exception of vandalism, 8 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 5 Other Crimes were reported.

There were 10 incidents of vandalism reported in October. This is a decline of 2 vandalism incidents reported during the month of September.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 16 adults and 10 juveniles during the month of October. In September, deputies made a total of 10 arrests.

### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of October approximately 9,286,969 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In September, approximately 7,887,966 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 8,373 bus boardings this month. This is an increase of 981 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (7,392).

During the month of October, deputies issued a total of 344 citations; in September, 273 citations were issued.

There were 8 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of October; during the month of September, there were 5 Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 14 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of October. In September, 11 Other Crimes were reported.

Eight incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is an increase of 6 when compared to the incidents reported last month (2).

Deputies arrested 54 adults and 12 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 54 arrests.

**NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 429 juvenile citations during the month of October.**

 2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON**





## 2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


## 2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON
