EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,607,227 during the month of January. In December, ridership was estimated at 1,517,600.

During the month of January, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 22% of the total ridership or 349,245 passengers. In December, deputies inspected 24% or 362,863 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,887. This is an increase of 71 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,816).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,482 fare-related citations, this is a decrease of 67 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in December (1,549).

Fare warnings decreased during this reporting period (130) when compared to the last reporting period (296).

During January, 16 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported. This is an increase of 2 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in December (14).

With the exception of vandalism, 5 Part II Crimes (Other Crimes) were reported. This is an increase of 3 when compared to the 2 Part II Crimes reported last month.

Two fewer incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of January (4). In December, 6 incidents of vandalism were reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 78 adults and 7 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 67 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of January, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 768,359. Ridership for the month of December was estimated at 786,729.

Green Line deputies inspected 16% of the total ridership or 119,781 passengers. During the month of December, deputies inspected 15% of the total ridership or 116,787 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in January is an increase of 2,994 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in December.

Green Line deputies issued 423 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 291 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of January, 273 were for fare-related violations; in December, 186 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 55 fare warnings issued during the month of January. When compared to those issued in December (113), fare warnings decreased by 58 during this reporting period.

There were 13 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of January. This is an increase of 3 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in December (10).

With the exception of vandalism, 7 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 2 Other Crimes were reported.

There were 7 incidents of vandalism reported in January. This is an increase of 1 vandalism incident reported during the month of December (6).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 28 adults and 8 juvenile during the month of January. In December, deputies made a total of 16 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of January approximately 8,598,020 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In December, approximately 7,899,411 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 9,590 bus boardings this month. This is an increase of 1,801 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (7,789).

During the month of January, deputies issued a total of 353 citations; in December, 253 citations were issued.

There were 6 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of January; during the month of December, there were 10 Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 7 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of January. In December, 10 Other Crimes were reported.

Five incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is a decrease of 21 when compared to the incidents reported last month (26).

Deputies arrested 46 adults and 14 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 41 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 530 juvenile citations during the month of January.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

The number of Citations, Fare Checks, Arrests and Ridership for the Red Line have increased in the month of January. Officers produced 1,387 Citations in January compared to 944 Citations in December, a 47.0% increase. Of these 1,387 Citations, 89.0% (1,234 citations) were for Fare Evasion. Transit Rail Officers increased the Fare Checks on the Red Line by 144,059 in January, a 24.3% increase from 592,156 in December to 736,215 in January. The Fare Checks in December is 20.6% of the total ridership. Officers gave 646 Fare Warnings in January, down 12.5% from 738 Warnings in December. The Red Line Ridership was 3,567,990 in January compared to 2,905,743 in December, a 22.8% increase. Reported Part I Crimes slipped 16.7% from 6 in December to 5 in January. There were 5 Vandalism incidents in December and 6 in January. Transit Rail Officers made 124 arrests in January, up 67.5% from 74 in December.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

While the total number of Bus Boardings, Arrests, Citations and Reported Crimes increased in the month of January, the total Bus Ridership and Vandalisms decreased. Transit Bus Officers conducted 9,627 Bus Boardings in January, up by 7.8% compared to 8,928 in December. There were 213 total reported crimes in January, not including Vandalism, compared to 205 in December. Part I Crimes decreased from 107 in December to 86 in January. There were 51 reported Robberies in January compared to 74 in December. The Transit Bus Ridership of 20,312,771 in December decreased by 21.6% to 15,918,619 in January. Transit Bus Division Officers made 106 arrests in January, up 21.8% from 87 in December. Vandalism decreased by 42.1%, from 19 in December to 11 in January.



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


