EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,625,412 during the month of February. In January, ridership was estimated at 1,607,227.

During the month of February, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 22% of the total ridership or 364,462 passengers. In January, deputies inspected 22% or 349,245 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 3,607. This is an increase of 720 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,887).

Blue Line deputies issued 2,078 fare-related citations, this is an increase of 596 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in January (1,482).

There were 685 fare warnings issued in the month of February. This is an increase of 555 when compared to the 130 fare warnings issued last month.

During February, 17 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported. This is an increase of 1 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in January (16).

With the exception of vandalism, 6 Part II Crimes (Other Crimes) were reported. This is an increase of 1 when compared to the 5 Part II Crimes reported last month.

Seven incidents of vandalism crimes were reported during the month of February. In January, 4 incidents of vandalism crimes were reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 91 adults and 8 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 85 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of February, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 630,800. Ridership for the month of January was estimated at 768,359.

Green Line deputies inspected 14% of the total ridership or 89,649 passengers. During the month of January, deputies inspected 16% of the total ridership or 119,781 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in February is a decrease of 30,132 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in January.

Green Line deputies issued 552 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 423 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of February, 413 were for fare-related violations; in January, 273 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 276 fare warnings issued in the month of February. When compared to those issued in January (55), fare warnings increased by 221.

There were 15 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of February. This is an increase of 2 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in January (13).

With the exception of vandalism, 5 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 7 Other Crimes were reported.

There were 3 incidents of vandalism crimes reported in February. This is a decrease of 4 vandalism crimes reported during the month of January (7).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 32 adults and 7 juvenile during the month of February. In January, deputies made a total of 36 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of February approximately 7,301,777 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In January, approximately 8,598,020 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 7,488 bus boardings this month. This is a decrease of 2,102 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (9,590).

During the month of February, deputies issued a total of 431 citations; in January, 353 citations were issued.

There were 5 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of February; during the month of January, there were 6 Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 12 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of February. In January, 17 Other Crimes were reported.

Seventeen incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is an increase of 12 when compared to the incidents reported last month (5).

Deputies arrested 91 adults and 11 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 60 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 779 juvenile citations during the month of February.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

Ridership, Fare Checks, Fare Warnings and Citations in the Red Line decreased slightly in the month of February. This is due largely to the fact that February only had 28 days and January had 31. Ridership per day decreased by 1.7% from 115,096 in January to 113,116 in February. Daily Fare Checks in January reduced by 524, from 23,748 to 23,224. Total Fare Checks of 650,285 or 20.5% of the total Ridership of 3,167,256. Average daily Fare Warnings slipped from 21 in January to 16 in February. Transit Rail Division Officers issued 1,256 Citations in February. 87.6% or 1,100 Citations were for Fare Evasion. On average, Officers issued 45 citations daily in January and February. Reported Part I and Part 2 Crimes in February was 50, which was 26.5% less than the reported 68 in January. Part I Crimes remained the same at 6 in both January and February. Transit Rail Officers made 160 arrests in February, up 29.% from 124 in January.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

While the total number of Bus Boardings, Reported Crimes and Vandalisms increased in the month of February, the total Bus Ridership, Arrests and Citations decreased. Transit Bus Officers conducted 10,829 Bus Boardings in February, up by 12.5% compared to 9,627 in January. There were 225 total reported crimes in February, not including Vandalism, compared to 213 in January. Part I Crimes decreased from 86 in January to 82 in February. There were 41 reported Robberies in February compared to 51 in January. Vandalism increased by 18.2%, from 11 in January to 13 in February. Average daily Transit Bus Ridership in January of 713,200 decreased 6% to 670,571 in February. Transit Bus Division Officers made an average of 3 arrests daily in January, down to an average of 2 in February. Officers produced a daily average of 25 citations in February, down 10.7% from an average of 28 in January.



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON







Serious Crimes (Part 1)








2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


