#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

---

##### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,789,444 during the month of March. In February, ridership was estimated at 1,625,412.

During the month of March, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 26% of the total ridership or 464,846 passengers. In February, deputies inspected 22% or 364,462 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 3,235. This is a decrease of 372 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (3,607).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,727 fare-related citations, this is a decrease of 351 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in February (2,078).

There were 1,178 fare warnings issued in the month of March. This is an increase of 493 when compared to the 685 fare warnings issued last month.

During March, 9 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported. This is a decrease of 8 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in February (17).

With the exception of vandalism, 1 Part II Crimes (Other Crimes) were reported. This is a decrease of 5 when compared to the 6 Part II Crimes reported last month.

Five incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of March. In February, 7 incidents of vandalism were reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 100 adults and 10 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 99 arrests.

### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of March, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 662,547. Ridership for the month of February was estimated at 630,800.

Green Line deputies inspected 16% of the total ridership or 102,834 passengers. During the month of February, deputies inspected 14% of the total ridership or 89,649 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in March is an increase of 13,185 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in February.

Green Line deputies issued 407 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 552 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of March, 269 were for fare-related violations; in February, 413 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 487 fare warnings issued in the month of March. When compared to those issued in February (276), fare warnings increased by 211.

There were 13 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of March. This is a decrease of 2 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in February (15).

With the exception of vandalism, 9 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 5 Other Crimes were reported.

There were 6 incidents of vandalism reported in March. This is an increase of 2 vandalism incidents reported during the month of February (4).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 38 adults and 8 juveniles during the month of March. In February, deputies made a total of 39 arrests.

### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of March approximately 8,574,479 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In February, approximately 7,301,777 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 10,694 bus boardings this month. This is an increase of 3,206 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (7,488).

During the month of March, deputies issued a total of 410 citations; in February, 431 citations were issued.

There were 5 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of March; during the month of February, there were also 5 Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 15 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of March. In February, 12 Other Crimes were reported.

Eleven incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is a decrease of 6 when compared to the incidents reported last month (17).

Deputies arrested 75 adults and 16 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 102 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 621 juvenile citations during the month of March.

#### LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

While ridership increased in the month of March, fare checks, fare warnings, citations, arrests and reported crimes in the Red Line decreased. Ridership increased 6.3% from 3,167,256 in February to 3,367,433 in March. Fare checks decreased 2.1% from 650,285 in February to 636,910 in March. The total fare checks in March was 636,910 or 18.9% of the total Ridership of 3,367,433. Average daily fare warnings slipped from 16 in February to 13 in March. Transit Rail Division Officers issued 1,122 citations in March, 89.8% or 1,008 Citations were for fare evasion. On average, Officers issued 36 citations daily in March, lower than January and February's average of 45. Reported Part I and Part 2 Crimes continued to decrease from 73 in January down to 55 in March. Part I Crimes decreased by 50% from 6 in February to 3 March. Transit Rail Officers made 98 arrests in March, down 38.8% from 160 in February.

#### LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

While the total number of reported crimes decreased in March, ridership, bus boardings, arrests, citations and vandalisms increased. There were 163 reported crimes in March, not including vandalism, compared to 225 in February. Ridership increased 17.4% from 18,775,999 in February to 22,048,660 in March. Transit Bus Officers conducted 12,728 bus boardings in March, up 17.5% compared to 10,829 in February. Part I Crimes decreased from 82 in February to 71 in March. However, there was an increase in reported robberies from 41 in February to 47 in March. Vandalism increased from 13 in February to 19 in March. Transit Bus Division Officers made 102 arrests in March compared to 61 arrests in February, a 67.2% increase. Officers produced 745 citations in March compared to 708 in February, a 5.2% increase.



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON



## 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

## 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON



## 2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON




