EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,870,534 during the month of April. In March, ridership was estimated at 1,789,444.

During the month of April, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 21% of the total ridership or 394,968 passengers. In March, deputies inspected 26% or 464,846 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,419. This is a decrease of 816 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (3,235).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,333 fare-related citations, this is a decrease of 394 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in March (1,727).

There were 763 fare warnings issued in the month of April. This is a decrease of 415 when compared to the 1,178 fare warnings issued last month.

During April, 9 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported; in March, there were also 9 Part I Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, there were no Part II (Other Crimes) reported during the month of April. Last month, 1 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported.

Five incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of April. In March, there were also 5 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 168 adults and 4 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 110 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of April, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 674,416. Ridership for the month of March was estimated at 662,547.

Green Line deputies inspected 12% of the total ridership or 83,538 passengers. During the month of March, deputies inspected 16% of the total ridership or 102,834 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in April is a decrease of 19,296 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in March.

Green Line deputies issued 419 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 407 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of April, 333 were for fare-related violations; in March, 269 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 474 fare warnings issued in the month of April. When compared to those issued in March (487), fare warnings decreased by 13.

There were 4 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of April. This is a decrease of 9 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in March (13).

With the exception of vandalism, 1 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 9 Other Crimes were reported.

There were 4 incidents of vandalism reported in April. This is a decrease of 2 vandalism incidents reported during the month of March (6).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 27 adults and 3 juveniles during the month of April. In March, deputies made a total of 46 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of April approximately 8,845,872 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In March, approximately 8,574,479 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 10,346 bus boardings this month. This is a decrease of 348 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (10,694).

During the month of April, deputies issued a total of 364 citations; in March, 410 citations were issued.

There were 6 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of April; during the month of March, there were 5 Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 15 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of April. In March, there were also 15 Other Crimes (Part II) reported.

Four incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is a decrease of 7 when compared to the vandalism incidents reported last month (11).

Deputies arrested 77 adults and 6 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 91 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 498 juvenile citations during the month of April.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

Officers' productivity increased in all categories from fare checks and citations to arrests. Ridership, vandalism and reported crimes were up as well. The only category that was down was fare warnings. Fare checks increased 22.5% from 636,910 in March to 780,327 in April. Transit Rail Officers issued 1,326 citations in April compared to 1,122 in March, an increase of 18.2%. Officers made 136 arrests in April compared to 98 in March, an increase of 38.8%. Ridership increased 5.7% from 3,367,433 in March to 3,558,246 in April. Vandalism increased slightly from 18 in March to 21 in April. Reported crimes increased from 55 in March to 69 in April. Fare warnings dropped from 392 in March to 365 in April.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

While ridership, arrests, reported crimes and vandalism increased in April, citations and bus boardings decreased. Ridership increased 3.2% from 22,048,660 in March to 22,746,528 in April. Officers made 139 arrests in April, 36.3% more than the 102 arrests in March. Vandalism increased from 19 in March to 26 in April. Reported crimes, 163 in March, increased 11.7% to 182 in April. Transit Bus Officers issued 533 citations in April compared to 745 in March, 28.5% less. Bus boardings decreased 13.4% from 12,728 in March to 11,017 in April.



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


