EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,956,606 during the month of May. In April, ridership was estimated at 1,870,534.

During the month of May, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 17% of the total ridership or 325,502 passengers. In April, deputies inspected 21% or 394,968 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,706. This is an increase of 287 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,419).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,630 fare-related citations. This is an increase of 297 fare-related citations when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in April (1,333).

There were 1,029 fare warnings issued in the month of May. This is an increase of 266 when compared to the 763 fare warnings issued last month.

During May, 10 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) were reported; in April, there were 9 Part I Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, there were 10 Part II (Other Crimes) reported during the month of May. Last month, there were 0 Part II Crimes (Other Crimes) reported.

Eight incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of May. In April, there were 5 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 242 adults and 16 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 172 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of May, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 688,830. Ridership for the month of April was estimated at 674,416.

Green Line deputies inspected 10% of the total ridership or 65,998 passengers. During the month of April, deputies inspected 12% of the total ridership or 83,538 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in May is a decrease of 17,540 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in April.

Green Line deputies issued 454 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period deputies issued 419 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of May, 396 were for fare-related violations; in April, 333 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 291 fare warnings issued in the month of May. When compared to those issued in April (474), fare warnings decreased by 183.

There were 8 Part I Crimes (Serious Crimes) reported during the month of May. This is an increase of 4 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in April (4).

With the exception of vandalism, 3 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported during this period; last reporting period, 1 Part II (Other Crimes) were reported.

There were 8 incidents of vandalism reported in May. This is an increase of 4 vandalism incidents reported during the month of April (4).

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 23 adults and 10 juveniles during the month of May. In April, deputies made a total of 30 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of May approximately 8,859,940 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In April, approximately 8,845,872 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 10,845 bus boardings this month. This is an increase of 499 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (10,346).

During the month of May, deputies issued a total of 425 citations; in April, 364 citations were issued.

There were 5 Serious Crimes (Part I) reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of May; during the month of April, there were 6 Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 5 Other Crimes (Part II) were reported during the month of May. In April, there were 15 Other Crimes (Part II) reported.

Five incidents of vandalism were reported during this reporting period. This is an increase of 1 when compared to the vandalism incidents reported last month (4).

Deputies arrested 81 adults and 6 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 83 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 682 juvenile citations during the month of May.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

Ridership and Officers' productivity increased in all categories in the month of May. Reported crimes and vandalism were down. Fare checks increased 2.2% from 780,327 in April to 797,614 in May. Fare warnings increased 35.9% from 365 in April to 496 in May. Transit Rail Officers issued 1,596 citations in May compared to 1,326 citations in April, an increase of 20.4%. Officers made 182 arrests in May compared to 136 arrests in April, an increase of 33.8%. Ridership increased from 3,558,246 in April to 3,558,884 in May. Vandalism decreased 47.6% from 21 in April to 11 in May. Reported crimes, excluding Vandalism, decreased 14.6% from 48 in April to 41 in May.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

Ridership and Officer's productivity increased in all categories in the month of May. Reported crimes and vandalism were down. Ridership increased from 22,746,528 in April to 22,782,704 in May. Officers' made 157 arrests in May compared to 139 arrests in April, a 12.9% increase. Transit bus Officers issued 533 citations in April compared to 540 in May, a 1.3% increase. Bus boardings increased 5.5% from 11,017 in April to 11,627 in May. Reported crimes, excluding vandalism, were down 16.5% from 182 in April to 152 in May. Vandalism decreased 7.7% from 26 in April to 24 in May.



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON





2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON



2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON


