#### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

##### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,919,600 during the month of June. In May, ridership was estimated at 1,956,606.

During the month of June, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 17% of the total ridership or 334,683 passengers. In May, deputies also inspected 17% or 325,502 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,187. This is a decrease of 519 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,706).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,233 fare-related citations. This is a decrease of 397 when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in May (1,630).

There were 963 fare warnings issued in the month of June. This is a decrease of 66 when compared to the 1,029 fare warnings issued last month.

During June, 7 Part I Serious Crimes were reported. In May, there were 10 Part I Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, there were 8 Part II Other Crimes reported. Last month, there were 10 Part II Other Crimes.

Six incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of June. In May, there were 8 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 149 adults and 4 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 258 arrests.

### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of June, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 605,030. Ridership for the month of May was estimated at 688,830.

Green Line deputies inspected 16% of the total ridership or 98,819 passengers. During the month of May, deputies inspected 10% of the total ridership or 65,998 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in June is an increase of 32,821 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in May.

Green Line deputies issued 293 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period, deputies issued 454 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of June, 236 were for fare-related violations; in May, 396 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 213 fare warnings issued in the month of June. When compared to those issued in May (291), fare warnings decreased by 78.

There were 4 Part I Serious Crimes reported in June. This is a decrease of 4 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in May (8).

With the exception of vandalism, 8 Part II Other Crimes were reported during this period; last reporting period, there were 3 Part II Other Crimes.

There were 7 incidents of vandalism reported this month. In May, there were 8 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 33 adults and 4 juveniles during the month of June. In May, deputies made a total of 33 arrests.

### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of June approximately 8,361,856 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In May, approximately 8,859,940 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 9,674 bus boardings this month. This is a decrease of 1,171 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (10,845).

During the month of June, deputies issued a total of 299 citations; in May, 425 citations were issued.

One Part I Serious Crime was reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of June; during the month of May, there were 5 Part I Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 10 Part II Other Crimes were reported during June. In May, there were 5 Part II Other Crimes reported.

Five incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of June, which is the same number of incidents reported in May.

Deputies arrested 62 adults and 6 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 87 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 446 juvenile citations during the month of June.

#### LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During 2001, transit crime on the Redline increased more than 200% compared to the previous year. This year to date, redline crime is down approximately 24%. When compared to May, reported crimes, arrests, fare checks, fare warnings and ridership were down in the month of June. Citation production stayed approximately the same. Reported crimes, not including vandalism, decreased 29.3% from 41 in May to 29 in June. Reported vandalism decreased 81.8% from 11 in May to 2 in June. Arrests were down 12.6% from 182 in May to 159 in June. Fare checks fell 4.6% from 797,614 in May to 760,968 in June. The fare warning's total of 410 in June was 17.3% less than the 496 conducted in May. Ridership decreased 6.9% from 3,558,884 in May to 3,313,175 in June. Citations increased by 3, from 1596 in May to 1599 in June.

#### LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

During 2001, bus transit related crime within the city increased by approximately 60% when compared to 2000. This year to date, bus crime is up approximately 2%. While reported crimes, vandalism, bus boardings and ridership were down in June, citations were up. Reported crimes, not including vandalism, decreased 5.2% from 152 in May to 144 in June. Reported vandalism dropped 25% from 24 in May to 18 in June. Bus boardings of 11,253 in June were 3.2% lower than May's total of 11,627. Bus ridership in June was 21,501,914 compared to 22,782,704 in May, a 5.6% decrease. Citations increased 18.5% from 540 in May to 640 in June. Arrests decreased 16.6% from 157 in May to 131 in June.

As noted in previous reports, the problem of unreported vandalism is still significant. It is estimated that the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority suffers a 13-million dollar expense each year associated with vandalism damage. The vast majority of these crimes, estimated to be several thousands, are not reported and therefore, are not reflected in this report.



## 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

Serious Crimes (Part 1)






## 2000 vs. 2001 MONTHLY COMPARISON







Serious Crimes (Part 1)







