EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,791,235 during the month of August. In July, ridership was estimated at 1,995,598.

During the month of August, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 24% of the total ridership or 429,090 passengers. In July, deputies also inspected 24% or 474,962 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,043. This is a decrease of 404 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,447).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,166 fare-related citations. This is a decrease of 68 when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in July (1,234).

There were 660 fare warnings issued in the month of August. This is a decrease of 76 when compared to the 736 fare warnings issued last month.

During August, 13 Part I Serious Crimes were reported. In July, 17 Part I Serious Crimes were reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 1 Part II Other Crime was reported. Last month, there were 5 Part II Other Crimes.

48 incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of August. In July, there were 19 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 172 adults and 10 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 162 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of August, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 709,392. Ridership for the month of July was estimated at 751,222.

Green Line deputies inspected 10% of the total ridership or 72,306 passengers. During the month of July, deputies inspected 11% of the total ridership or 80,288 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in August is a decrease of 7,982 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in July.

Green Line deputies issued 245 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period, deputies issued 401 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of August, 209 were for fare-related violations; in July, 335 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 121 fare warnings issued in the month of August. When compared to those issued in July (179), fare warnings decreased by 58.

There were 13 Part I Serious Crimes reported in August. This is an increase of 2 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in July (11).

With the exception of vandalism, 4 Part II Other Crimes were reported during this period; last reporting period, there were 2 Part II Other Crimes.

There were 4 incidents of vandalism reported this month. In July, there were 5 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 27 adults and 4 juveniles during the month of August. In July, deputies made a total of 40 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of August approximately 8,319,170 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In July, approximately 8,756,835 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 9,249 bus boardings this month. This is a decrease of 101 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (9,350). Bus boardings were affected this month by focusing on a growing problem at bus stops. We conducted several special operations in West LA and Santa Monica addressing transients camping at and near bus stop benches. Our operations were in partnership with Co. Public Works, Mental Health and MTA clean up crews. Problems in the focused areas were abated.

During the month of August, deputies issued a total of 482 citations; in July, 438 citations were issued.

Four Part I Serious Crimes was reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of August; during the month of July, there were also 4 Part I Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 7 Part II Other Crimes were reported during August. In July, there were 10 Part II Other Crimes reported.

There were 6 incidents of vandalism reported during the month of August. In July, no incidents of vandalism were reported.

Deputies arrested 93 adults and 3 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 128 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 400 juvenile citations during the month of August.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During 2001, transit crime on the Redline increased more than 200% compared to the previous year. This year to date, Redline crime is down approximately 12%. When compared to July, only vandalism went down in August. Citations, arrests, fare checks, fare warnings, reported crimes and ridership were up. Reported vandalism was reduced to 0 in August from 8 in July. Transit Rail Officers produced 1,549 citations in July compared to 1,882 in August, a 21.5% increase. Officers made 122 in August, 82.1% more than the 67 arrests in July. Officers conducted 913,876 fare checks in August compared to 784,299 in July, a 16.5% increase. Fare warnings went up 284.8% from 501 in July to 1,928 in August. Reported crimes, excluding vandalism, increased 6.3% from 64 in July to 68 in August. Redline ridership went up 2.3% from 3,596,772 in July to 3,678,237 in August. Please note that MTA revised the ridership in July from 3,542,492 to 3,596,772.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

During 2001, bus transit related crime within the city increased by approximately 60% when compared to 2000. This year to date, bus crime is down by 1.86%. While ridership, arrests, reported crimes, vandalism and bus boardings were down in August, citations were up. Ridership decreased 5.0 % from 22,517,575 in July to 21,392,150 in August. Transit Bus Officers made 144 arrests in July compared to 118 in August, a 18.1% decrease. Reported crimes, not including vandalism, decreased 33.3% from 183 in July to 122 in August. Reported vandalism decreased slightly from 19 in July to 18 in August. Officers conducted 12,014 bus boardings in July compared to 11,962 in August, a 0.4% decrease. Officers produced 498 citations in July compared to 571 in August, 14.7% increase.

As noted in previous reports, the problem of unreported vandalism is still significant. It is estimated that the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority suffers a 13-million dollar expense each year associated with vandalism damage. The vast majority of these crimes, estimated to be several thousand, are not reported and therefore, are not reflected in this report.



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON





Serious Crimes (Part 1)











2001-vs-2002 Serious Crimes (Part I)






2001-VS-2002 Serious Crimes (Part I)




