EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,869,276 during the month of September. In August, ridership was estimated at 1,791,235.

During the month of September, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 24% of the total ridership or 455,041 passengers. In August, deputies also inspected 24% or 429,090 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,448. This is an increase of 405 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,043).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,154 fare-related citations. This is a decrease of 12 when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in August (1,166).

There were 850 fare warnings issued in the month of September. This is an increase of 190 when compared to the 660 fare warnings issued last month.

During September, 19 Part I Serious Crimes were reported. In August, 13 Part I Serious Crimes were reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 9 Part II Other Crimes were reported. Last month, one Part II Other Crime was reported.

31 incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of September. In August, there were 48 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 157 adults and 11 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 182 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of September, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 690,300. Ridership for the month of August was estimated at 709,392.

Green Line deputies inspected 11% of the total ridership or 76,027 passengers. During the month of August, deputies inspected 10% of the total ridership or 72,306 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in September is an increase of 3,721 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in August.

Green Line deputies issued 242 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period, deputies issued 245 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of September, 189 were for fare-related violations; in August, 209 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 151 fare warnings issued in the month of September. When compared to those issued in August (121), fare warnings increased by 30.

There were 14 Part I Serious Crimes reported in September. This is an increase of 1 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in August (13).

With the exception of vandalism, 4 Part II Other Crimes were reported during this period; last reporting period, there were also 4 Part II Other Crimes.

There were 12 incidents of vandalism reported this month. In August, there were 4 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 29 adults and 2 juveniles during the month of September. In August, deputies made a total of 31 arrests.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL

During the month of September approximately 8,147,226 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In August, approximately 8,319,170 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 8,823 bus boardings this month, compared to the 9,249 bus boardings conducted last month.

During the month of September, deputies issued a total of 451 citations; in August, 482 citations were issued.

Five Part I Serious Crimes were reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of September; during the month of August, there were 4 Part I Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 4 Part II Other Crimes were reported during September. In August, there were 7 Part II Other Crimes reported.

There were 7 incidents of vandalism reported during the month of September. In August, 6 incidents of vandalism were reported.

Deputies arrested 94 adults and 7 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 96 arrests.

NOTE: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 356 juvenile citations during the month of September.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

During 2001, transit crime on the Redline increased more than 200% compared to the previous year. This year to date, Redline crime is down approximately 7%. When compared to August, arrests and vandalism went up in September. Ridership, fare checks, fare warnings, reported crimes and citations were down. Redline ridership went down 11.1% from 3,678,237 in August to 3,268,996 in September. Officers conducted 913,876 fare checks in August compared to 757,110 in September, a 17.2% decrease. Fare warnings went down 78.2% from 1,928 in August to 420 in September. Reported crimes, excluding vandalism, decreased 14.7% from 68 in August to 58 in September. Reported vandalism rose from 0 in August to 7 in September. Transit Rail Officers produced 1,503 citations in September, 20.1% less than the 1,882 in August. Transit Rail Officers made 122 arrests in August compared to 134 in September, a 9.8% increase.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

During 2001, transit related bus crime within the city increased by approximately 60% when compared to 2000. This year to date, bus crime is down by 2.46%. While ridership, bus boardings, vandalism, citations and arrests were down in September, reported crimes were up. Ridership decreased 2.1 % from 21,392,150 in August to 20,950,008 in September. Officers conducted 11,962 bus boardings in August compared to 10,744 in September, a 10.2% decrease. Reported vandalism decreased 5.6 % from 18 in August to 17 in September. Officers produced 571 citations in August compared to 473 in September, a 17.2% decrease. Officers made 87 arrests in September, 40.4% less compared to 146 arrests in August. Reported crimes, excluding vandalism, increased 28.7% from 122 in August to 157 in September.

As noted in previous reports, the problem of unreported vandalism is still significant. It is estimated that the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority suffers a 13-million dollar expense each year associated with vandalism damage. The vast majority of these crimes, estimated to be several thousand, are not reported and therefore, are not reflected in this report.

 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON**





2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON



2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON










2001-VS-2002 Serious Crimes (Part I)



2001-vs-2002 Other Crimes (Part 2)












