### EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

#### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,762,291 during the month of October. In September, ridership was estimated at 1,869,276.

During the month of October, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 36% of the total ridership or 626,991 passengers. In September, deputies inspected 24% or 455,041 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,678. This is an increase of 230 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,448).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,520 fare-related citations. This is an increase of 366 when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in September (1,154).

There were 1,128 fare warnings issued in the month of October. This is an increase of 278 when compared to the 850 fare warnings issued last month.

During October, 13 Part I Serious Crimes were reported. In September, 19 Part I Serious Crimes were reported.

With the exception of vandalism, there were no Part II Other Crimes reported. Last month, 9 Part II Other Crime were reported.

16 incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of October. In September, there were 31 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 177 adults and 12 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 168 arrests.

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### LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

During the month of October, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 644,680. Ridership for the month of September was estimated at 690,300.

Green Line deputies inspected 11% of the total ridership or 70,616 passengers. During the month of September, deputies also inspected 11% of the total ridership or 76,027 passengers. The number of passengers inspected in October is a decrease of 5,411 when compared to the number of passengers inspected in September.

Green Line deputies issued 322 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period, deputies issued 242 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of October, 239 were for fare-related violations; in September, 189 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 304 fare warnings issued in the month of October. When compared to those issued in September (151), fare warnings increased by 153.

There were 8 Part I Serious Crimes reported in October. This is a decrease of 6 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in September (14).

With the exception of vandalism, 4 Part II Other Crimes were reported during this period; last reporting period, there were also 4 Part II Other Crimes.

There were 6 incidents of vandalism reported this month. In September, there were 12 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 47 adults and 6 juveniles during the month of October. In September, deputies made a total of 31 arrests.

### **LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - BUS PATROL**

During the month of October approximately 9,047,947 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In September, approximately 8,147,226 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 8,332 bus boardings this month, compared to the 8,823 bus boardings conducted last month.

During the month of October, deputies issued a total of 450 citations; in September, 451 citations were issued.

Eight Part I Serious Crimes were reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of October; during the month of September, there were 5 Part I Serious Crimes reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 14 Part II Other Crimes were reported during October. In September, there were 4 Part II Other Crimes reported.

There were 18 incidents of vandalism reported during the month of October. In September, 7 incidents of vandalism were reported.

Deputies arrested 84 adults and 5 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 101 arrests.

NOTES: Deputies assigned to the Blue Line, Green Line and Bus Patrol issued a total of 505 juvenile citations during the month of October.

Transit Services Bureau is re-evaluating the vandalism reporting process for a more accurate account of the number of actual vandalism incidents reported.

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### LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

This year to date, Redline crime is down approximately 6%. When compared to September, ridership, fare checks, citations and arrests went up in October. Fare warnings, reported crimes and vandalism were down. Redline ridership went up 5.5% from 3,268,996 in September to 3,448,929 in October. There was a slight increase in fare checks from 757,110 in September compared to 757,240 in October. Transit Rail Officers produced 1,503 citations in September compared to 1880 in October, a 25.1% increase. Transit Rail Officers made 134 arrests in September compared to 182 in October, a 34.3% increase. Fare warnings saw no significant change decreasing from 420 in September to 419 October. Reported crimes, excluding vandalism, decreased 24.1% from 58 in September to 44 in October. Reported vandalism saw a slight decrease from 7 in September to 6 in October, a 14.3% decrease.

### LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

This year to date, bus crime is down by 3.30%. All statistical categories went up in October. Bus ridership increased 11.1% from 20,950,008 in September to 23,266,149 in October. Officers conducted 10,744 bus boardings in September compared to 12,322 in October, a 14.7% increase. Reported Crimes, excluding vandalism, went up 15.3% from 157 in September compared to 181 in October. Reported vandalism went up slightly from 17 in September to 18 in October. Officers produced 473 citations in September compared to 610 in October, a 29% increase. Officers made 87 arrests in September compared to 117 in October, a 34.5% increase.



## 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

## 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON







## 2001 vs. 2002 MONTHLY COMPARISON

Serious Crimes (Part 1)



