 2002 vs. 2003 MONTHLY COMPARISON**





2002 vs. 2003 MONTHLY COMPARISON

2002 vs. 2003 MONTHLY COMPARISON



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue line was listed at 1,818,983 for the month of January. A total of 34% of the riders were inspected for fare.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 2,730. This is an increase of 382 citations when compared to the total citations issued last month (2,348).

Blue Line deputies issued 1,261 fare-related citations. This is an increase of 177 when compared to the number of fare-related citations issued in December (1,084).

There were 1188 fare warnings issued in the month of January. This is a decrease of 624 when compared to the 1812 fare warnings issued last month.

During January, 13 Part I Serious Crimes were reported. In December, 11 Part I Serious Crimes were reported.

With the exception of vandalism, there were 14 Part II Other Crimes reported. Last month, there was also 14 Part II Other Crimes.

Four incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of December. In December, there was also 4 incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 130 adults and 6 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 119 arrests.

Deputies arrested four for assaults, eight for narcotics violations, one for weapons violations, and 107 for warrants.

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO GREEN LINE

Ridership for the Green line was listed at 823,542 for the month of January. A total of 10% of the riders were checked for fare.

Green Line deputies issued 245 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period, deputies issued 251 citations.

Of the total citations issued during the month of January, 188 were for fare-related violations; in December, 251 fare-related citations were issued.

There were 358 fare warnings issued in the month of January. When compared to those issued in December (249), fare warnings increased by 109.

There were 11 Part I Serious Crimes reported in January. This is a decrease of 2 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in December (13).

With the exception of vandalism, 15 Part II Other Crimes were reported during this period; last reporting period, there were 7 Part II Other Crimes.

There were 8 incidents of vandalism reported this month. In December, there were 8 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 39 adults and no juveniles during the month of January. In December, deputies made a total of 36 arrests.

Deputies arrested one for robbery, one for assaults, eight for theft, two for narcotics violations, and twenty one for warrants.

During the month of January approximately 8,288,282 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In December, approximately 8,171,820 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 8,234 bus boardings this month. This is a increase of 561 when compared to the number of bus boardings conducted last month (7,673).

During the month of January, deputies issued a total of 387 citations; in December, 522 citations were issued.

Five Part I Serious Crimes was reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of January; during the month of December, three Part I Serious Crime was reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 18 Part II Other Crimes were reported during January. In December, there were 40 Part II Other Crimes reported.

There were 10 incidents of vandalism reported during the month of January. In December, 5 incidents of vandalism were reported.

Deputies arrested 91 adults and 2 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 95 arrests.

Deputies arrested three for assaults, seven for narcotics violations, one for sex offenses, two for weapons violations, and thirty eight for warrants.






2002-vs-2003 Serious Crimes (Part I)










2002-VS-2003 Serious Crimes (Part I)







LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT RAIL DIVISION

This month's redline crime is down 37% compared to January, 2002. When compared to December, 2002, fare checks, arrests, reported crimes excluding vandalism and vandalism went down. There was a 7.72% decrease in fare checks from 612,755 in December to 565,462 in January. Transit Rail Division officers made 103 arrests in December compared to 79 in January, a 23.3% decrease. Fare warnings saw an increase from 441 in December to 447 in January. Reported crimes excluding vandalism decreased 21.43% from 56 in December to 44 in January. Reported vandalism dropped to 2 in January from 4 in December. Transit officers produced 1,439 citations in December compared to 1,483 in January, a 3.06% increase.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT - TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

This month's bus crime is down 27.23% compared to January, 2002. Compared to December, 2002 all statistical figures went down. Fare checks for December were 10,198 compared to 9,986 in January, a 2.08% decrease. Transit Bus Division officers produced 464 citations in December compared to 365 in January, a 21.34% decrease. Arrests for December were 227 compared to 99 in January, a 56.39% decrease. Reported crimes excluding vandalism also decreased. There were 144 reported crimes in December compared to 141 in January, a 2.08% decrease. Reported vandalism likewise decreased from 19 in December to 14 in January.
