



EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

LOS ANGELES COUNTY SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT - METRO BLUE LINE

Ridership for the Blue Line was estimated at 1,664,928 during the month of February. In January, ridership was estimated at 1,818,983.

During the month of February, deputies assigned to the Blue Line inspected 26% of the total ridership or 426,883 passengers. In January, deputies inspected 34% or 613,853 passengers.

Blue Line citations, including photo enforcement, totaled 1,479. In January, deputies issued 2,730 citation.

Blue Line deputies issued 697 fare-related citations. In January, deputies issued 1,633 fare-related citations.

There were 853 fare warnings issued in the month of February. In January there was a total of 1,188 fare warnings issued.

During February, 25 Part I Serious Crimes were reported. In January, 13 Part I Serious Crimes were reported.

With the exception of vandalism, there were 16 Part II Other Crimes reported. Last month, there were 14 Part II Other Crimes.

Four incidents of vandalism were reported during the month of February. In January, there was also four incidents of vandalism reported within the Blue Line's jurisdiction.

Blue Line deputies arrested 122 adults and 8 juveniles during this reporting period; last month deputies made 136 arrests.

Blue Line deputies arrested two for robbery, five for battery/assaults, seven for theft/vehicle burglary, and seven for narcotics.

During the month of February, ridership for the Green Line was estimated at 756,993. Ridership for the month of February was estimated at 823,542.

Green Line deputies inspected 10% of the total ridership or 77,353 passengers. During the month of January, deputies inspected 10% of the total ridership or 82,052 passengers.

Green Line deputies issued 139 citations during this reporting period. Last reporting period, deputies issued 245 citations.

were issued.

There were 300 fare warnings issued in the month of February. In January, 358 fare warnings were issued.

There were 21 Part I Serious Crimes reported in February. This is an increase of 16 when compared to the Serious Crimes reported in January (5).

With the exception of vandalism, 6 Part II Other Crimes were reported during this period; last reporting period, there were 15 Part II Other Crimes.

There were 11 incidents of vandalism reported this month. In January, there were 2 incidents of vandalism reported.

Deputies assigned to the Green Line arrested 16 adults and 5 juveniles during the month of February. In January, deputies made a total of 39 arrests.

Deputies arrested one for assault, two for theft / auto burglary, and two for narcotics violations.

During the month of February, approximately 7,828,575 passengers patronized the busses patrolled by TSB deputies. In January, approximately 7,840,421 passengers patronized the busses.

Deputies conducted 6,234 bus boardings this month. In January, 8,234 bus boarding were conducted.

During the month of February, deputies issued a total of 331 citations; in January, 387 citations were issued.

Eight Part I Serious Crimes was reported within bus patrol's jurisdiction for the month of February; during the month of January, five Part I Serious Crime was reported.

With the exception of vandalism, 21 Part II Other Crimes were reported during February. In January, there were 18 Part II Other Crimes reported.

There were three incidents of vandalism reported during the month of February. In January, 10 incidents of vandalism were reported.

Deputies arrested 73 adults and 2 juveniles during this reporting period; last month, deputies made a total of 93 arrests.

Deputies arrested four for assaults, and seven for narcotics violations during February.






2002-vs-2003 Serious Crimes (Part I)








2002-vs-2003 Serious Crimes (Part I)






