




2002-vs-2003 Serious Crimes (Part I)











2002-VS-2003 Serious Crimes (Part I)







Redline ridership increased slightly from 2,685,255 in March to 2,706,192 in April. Crimes declined 13.3% from 15 in March to 13 in April. Arrests were down 47.4% from 19 in March to 10 in April.

LOS ANGELES POLICE DEPARTMENT – TRANSIT BUS DIVISION

Bus ridership in April of 21,973,872 was 1.7% less than the 22,360,535 in March.

Total crimes, excluding vandalism, increased from 57 in March to 60 in April. Reported vandalism also went up from 2 in March to 4 in April. Arrests, however, decreased 40.7% from 27 in March to 16 in April.
