





The LASD reserve units are attached to regular LASD units of assignments. The reserves are there to perform the same function as any deputy. In that way, the reserves augment the force at no increase in cost. Contract agencies benefit significantly by the presences of reserves since they are directly paying for the LASD contract and do not have to pay for the additional reserve force.

Reserve units are directed by a regular Sgt that acts as the official coordinator for the unit. TSB West has grown since it was founded one year ago with two reserves, to our now unit strength of six. At our July graffiti operation detail with LAPD, our TSB West had a 100% attendance for the operation. That was six additional personnel for the detail at no additional cost.

All Reserve, Volunteer, and Explorer Companies are required to take light and heavy rail training just as all TSB deputy personnel. Currently, all three programs are being trained for graffiti report writing, bus jumping, and under cover operations. Companies assigned to TSB have duties that include community relations, crime prevention, and patrol on all transit systems. 




