





The LASD reserve units are attached to regular LASD units of assignments. The reserves are there to perform the same function as any deputy. In that way, the reserves augment the force at no increase in cost. Contact agencies benefit significantly by the presences of reserves since they are directly paying for the LASD contract and do not have to pay for the additional reserve force..

Reserve Units are directed by a regular Sgt, that acts as the official coordinator for the unit.

All Reserve, Volunteer, and Explorer Companies are required to take light and heavy rail training just as all TSB deputy personnel. Currently, all three programs are being trained for graffiti report writing, bus jumping, and under cover operations. 


