





ALLOCATION OF LAW ENFORCEMENT SERVICES JULY 2007

Transit Services Bureau personnel responded to a total of **1,714** calls for service during this reporting period. The following is a breakdown of the type of call (Emergency, Priority, Routine), the number of minutes required to respond to the call, and the average for each category.

*Each month, Reserve totals will display totals from the previous month because totals are not submitted until the end of each month.

The LASD reserve units are attached to regular LASD units of assignments. The reserves are there to perform the same function as any deputy. In that way, the reserves augment the force at no increase in cost. Contract agencies benefit significantly by the presences of reserves since they are directly paying for the LASD contract and do not have to pay for the additional reserve force.

Reserve units are directed by a regular Sergeant that acts as the official coordinator for the unit.

All Reserve, Volunteer, and Explorer Companies are required to take light and heavy rail training just as all TSB deputy personnel. Currently, all three programs are being trained for graffiti report writing, bus jumping, and under cover operations. Companies assigned to TSB have duties that include community relations, crime prevention, and patrol on all transit systems. For more information on these programs, please visit www.lasdreseve.org.




