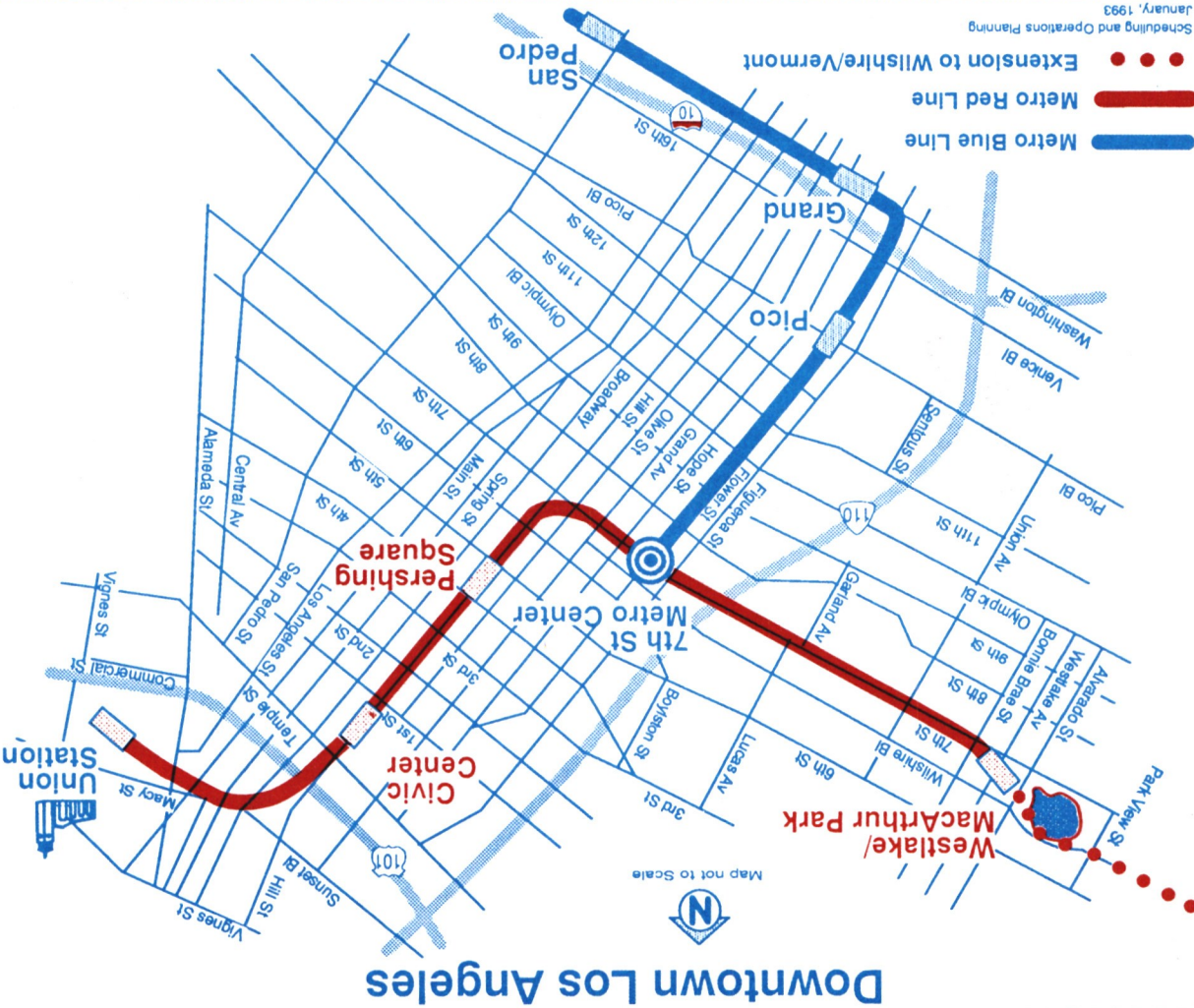

- Passengers destined for the Civic Center can transfer to the Metro Red Line.
