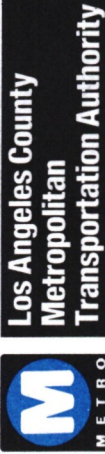

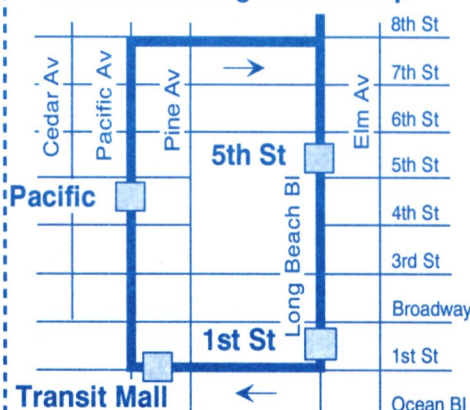

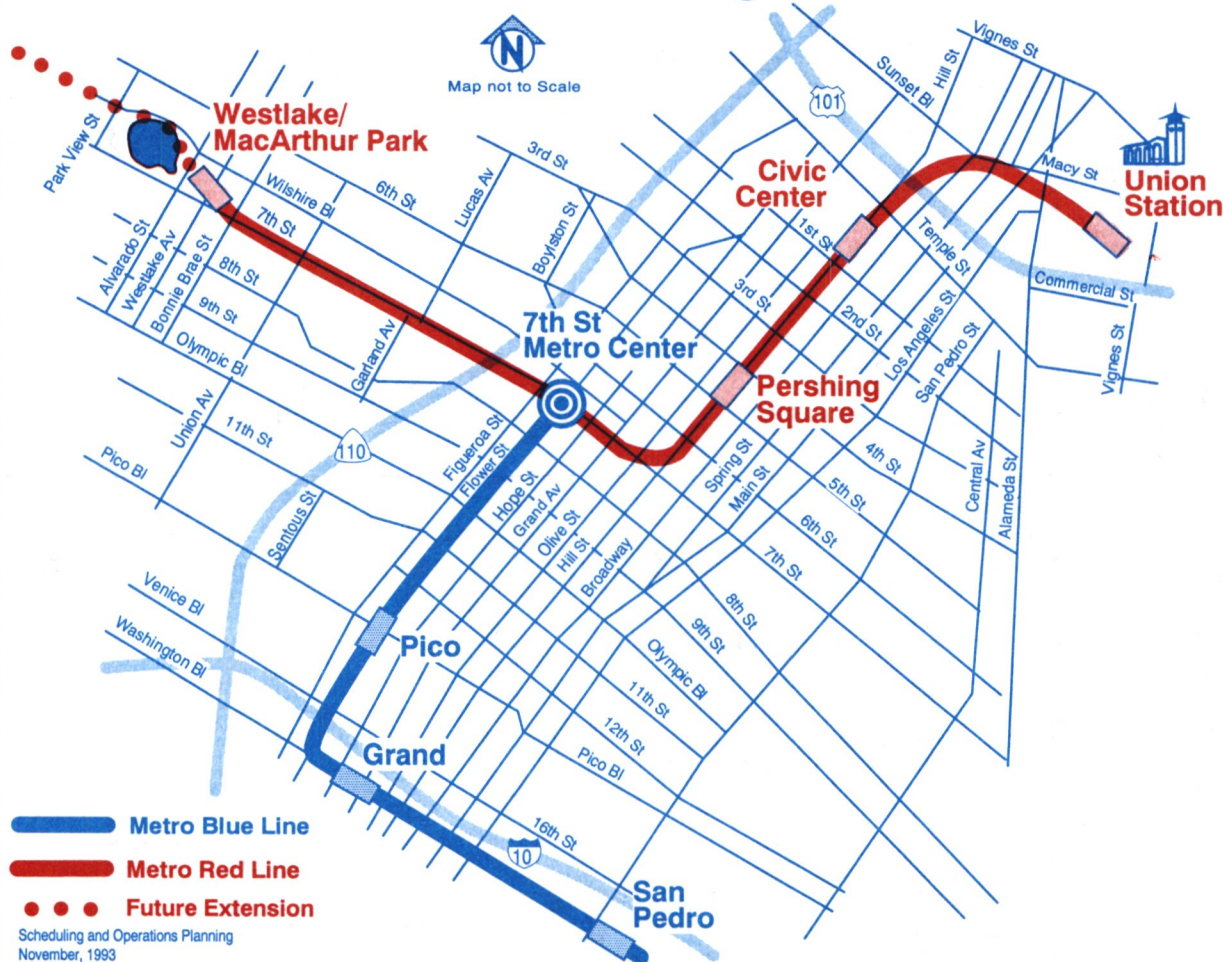
Downtown Long Beach Loop

Tips for Easy Riding on the Metro Blue Line

- Ride the Metro Blue Line for MTA Local Base Fare (\$1.10).
 - Save money with an MTA monthly Pass...unlimited riding for the price of a base pass (\$42).
 - If you board with a transfer or a ticket, keep it handy as proof of Metro Blue Line fare payment.
 - All service provided on the Metro Blue Line is accessible to the disabled.
 - Passengers destined for the Civic Center can transfer to the Metro Red Line.
 - Be safety smart! Stand back from the edge of the platform as trains arrive and depart.
 - Please, while riding on the train, keep your feet off the seats.
 - For Passengers with a Cycle Express Permit, the MTA will allow bikes on the Metro Blue Line.
