Operators Asked For Input Into Training Program

RTD's operators recently received questionnaires mailed to their homes asking them what areas they would like to see included in a training program for bus operators.

The questionnaires were the first step in developing such a program and consisted of 14 items ranging from questions on human behavior and better communication with the public to questions of legal responsibilities and safety. Operators were asked to select the areas in which they thought training for operators might be useful.

The answers will be analyzed and the results incorporated into an in-service training program for both current and future RTD operators. The program is tentatively slated to start in August.

The questionnaire was devised by RTD's new director of training, Ms. Joanne Bowman, who is coordinating the planning and development of the program. She will be working with a training committee consisting of Bill Packard, RTD's chief instructor; Bob Mann, RTD's chief special agent; and Don Cornish, RTD labor relations representative. Leonard Steinberg, PhD, psychologist and professor at Cal State, L.A., who was a consultant for a training program for the Los Angeles Police Department, is also on the training committee.

New Uniforms For Drivers

Increased Uniform Allowance As First Step

Operators recently received an increased uniform allowance as their first step toward getting new uniforms.

The one-time allowance of \$150 was agreed to by the District and the United Transportation Union in order to provide every operator with a new style and color of uniform. For this contract year, it replaces the uniform allowance referred to in the SCRTD-UTU labor contract.

The increased allowance will be applied to purchasing the new uniforms after the uniform selection committee has selected the style and color of the uniforms.

Walsh In Transportation Post

John H. Walsh, formerly RTD's Director of Safety, has been named as the District's new General Superintendent of Transportation. Walsh will replace John T. Johnson, who retired July 18 after 38 years of service.

The red-and-white bulletins are sent to all RTD offices, transportation and maintenance facilities. Employees should check the bulletin boards at their work location. The bulletins are posted from a period of one week to one month, depending on the position, so the bulletin boards should be checked frequently.

Employees Urged to Apply for Non-Contract Positions

Many RTD employees aren't aware of non-contract positions for which they may be qualified, according to RTD senior personnel analyst Yolanda Bruton.

"We know we have a lot of qualified employees for the many entry level jobs within the District," says Mrs. Bruton, "but it is the employee's responsibility to read the job vacancy bulletins regularly and to send in a resume in application."

The job vacancy bulletins are posted at all RTD facilities. Bulletins are white with red headings, and are usually posted from seven to 30 days. Interested employees are urged to submit a resume to the Personnel Department. The resume must be received by Personnel no later than 5 p.m. on the closing day.

After resumes have been received, the Personnel Department screens the resumes for eligibility and applicants not meeting the minimum qualifications are notified. Applicants meeting the minimum qualifications are then interviewed.

The interview team will consist of at least 2 members: one member from the department in which the vacancy exists; one member from the Personnel Department; and in most cases a third member from another department is included to assure greater objectivity in the selection of applicants.

The interview team rates the candidates on the basis of capabilities, experience and training pertinent to the job. The candidates' scores and scoring data are for-

warded in a confidential memorandum to the head of the department in which the vacancy is to be filled. Normally, the department head recommends the appointment of the top candidate, with the general manager giving final approval.

Posting non-contract job vacancy bulletins has been RTD policy since 1972, according to Mrs. Bruton who explains: "RTD wants the employees to know that promotional opportunities are available and that the District has an objective process of selecting the best applicant. We feel that candidates with prior District experience are ideal for many of the positions. Only if there aren't enough qualified applications from District personnel for these jobs do we go outside of RTD to recruit applicants."

Mrs. Bruton also emphasizes that the job vacancy notices should be read very carefully. "Many times an employee will see that the job requires a four-year degree and then won't look further. However, whenever appropriate, experience with the District can be substituted for part or all of the education requirements." She adds that "the Personnel Department tries to make every effort to substitute experience with the District when at all possible."
