LASD, LAPD want Metro Bus Operators to go 'S-L-O-W'



(September 16) Every Metro Bus operator should go S-L-O-W if an emergency incident occurs on a bus.

That's the advice of Sheriff's Capt. Marc Klugman, who notes that decals with the letters **S-L-O-W** have been placed on the dashboards of all Metro Buses. If an incident occurs, operators can use the acronym to remember how to react to the emergency.

Following the S-L-O-W formula will help police officers who are dispatched to respond to an emergency call. The letters stand for:

S - Stop the bus in an area of clear

visibility.

L – Lights inside the bus should be turned on, outside lights should be turned off.

O – Open doors and turn off engine.

W – Walk away from the bus toward police officers.
