

You Can Run, But You Can't Hide, Juvenile Camp Escapees Learn

(Jan. 21) Three boys who ran away from the Camp Glen Rocky juvenile facility in San Dimas, recently, were corralled by the long arm of the law when they tried to catch a bus at the El Monte Bus Terminal.

Spotted by a security guard as they loitered near the buses, the suspects were approached by plainclothes Sheriff's deputies. All three boys were dressed in California Youth Authority uniforms, but had turned their T-shirts inside-out to hide the lettering.

Booked for escape

One suspect ran, but the officers handcuffed the other two. After a short foot pursuit, the third youth was captured. The three were booked at the Sheriff's Temple station for felony escape.

Youth Authority officers had mounted a search for the juveniles, who had walked away from the camp earlier in the day. They had been in custody on narcotics, grand theft and burglary charges.
