## MTA Will Mail W-2 Forms to Employees This Year

(Jan. 26) This year, the MTA will mail W-2 forms to employees' homes or designated addresses instead of handing them out in the workplace.

"The MTA, as the employer, is required to issue W-2s no later than January 31," said Terry Matsumoto, executive officer, Finance. "Employees should receive them within the first four days of February."

## **Lingering Y2K issues**

Matsumoto said lingering Y2K issues with certain computer programs were factors in the decision to mail the W-2 forms this year. And, with Jan. 31 falling on a Monday, there would not be sufficient time, he said, to route the W-2s to all MTA locations and still comply with the law.
