Gateway Media Event Launches Low-Income Tax Program

(March 14, 2002) Los Angeles City Council members Ed Reyes and Eric Garcetti were among the speakers at a Gateway news conference to kick off this year's Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC) campaign.

Locally, the campaign is a special partnership created by the County and City of Los Angeles, the IRS and the MTA to inform low-income wage earners with children of their potential qualification for up to \$4,008 in special federal income tax credits and refunds.

The program includes the new Child Tax Credit, worth up to \$600 per child. Last year's campaign generated \$30 million in additional tax credits and refunds for LA workers.
