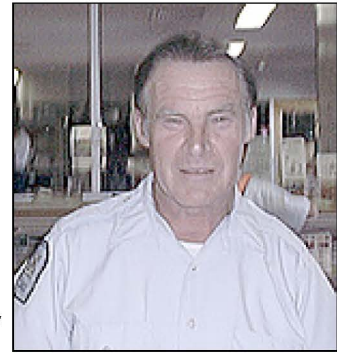
Mynster's letter reads:
