On-Board Video Camera Catches Alleged Robber in the Act

(Dec. 10, 2004) It was the tiny eye of an on-board camera that caught a young man in the act of robbing a Metro Bus passenger of her purse, money, credit cards and cell phone, Oct. 28, in Burbank.

And when the Transit Services Bureau circulated a photo of the suspect to law enforcement officers, a Sheriff's Department security assistant working the Burbank Court identified North Hollywood resident Alejandro Camacho, 20, as the alleged robber.

Bureau detectives Brian Morano and Ron Smith arrested Camacho at his home early Thursday morning. He was charged with armed robbery and is being held on \$100,000 bail at the Twin Towers jail.

A search of Camacho's residence turned up some of the clothing and property taken during the robbery.
