Public Open House at Artesia Transit Center, June 29

(June 22, 2005) Members of the South Bay community will learn about the public transit options in their area during an Open House at the Artesia Transit Center, Wednesday, June 29.

Sponsored by the South Bay Service Sector, the Open House will be held from 6:30 a.m. and 6 p.m. at the facility, located just off the I-110 Harbor Transitway on West 182nd Street.

Open House attendees will be among the first in the South Bay to ride new Metro Express Line 450X, which should whisk commuters into downtown LA in 25-30 minutes with only one stop at the Harbor Transitway/I-105 station. Metro will provide free rides on the new Metro Express starting Monday, June 27 through Wednesday, June 29.

Ten Metro and two local bus lines serve the Artesia Transit Center, which has 900 free park & ride spaces for commuters. Metro will set up several information tables on the bus loading platform and will distribute information on South Bay Services, including bus and rail timetable information.
