## Downtown Bus Service Rerouted for Friday’s Mayoral Inaugural

(June 29, 2005) Some Metro Bus service in downtown LA will be rerouted Friday, July 1, due to activities before and after the inauguration of Antonio Villaraigosa as mayor of Los Angeles.

The service detours will begin on most streets around 8:30 a.m. and will end at 11:30 a.m. Only Metro Bus Lines 33, 92, 434 will be detoured from 5 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.

All Metro Bus stops will be posted with instructions on where to board buses during the detours. The Metro Red Line, with stops at Pershing Square and Civic Center, will be the best way to avoid traffic.

Metro Bus service will be detoured on:

- Temple Street between Alameda Street and Grand Avenue.
- First Street between Broadway and Los Angeles Street.
- Spring Street between Aliso Street and Second Street.
- Main Street between Aliso Street and First Street.
- Broadway between Aliso Street and First Street.
- Hill Street between Aliso Street and First Street.

Forty-eight Metro Bus lines will be affected. They are Lines 2, 4, 10, 11, 28, 30, 31, 33, 38, 40, 42, 45, 46, 48, 68, 71, 76, 78, 79, 81, 83, 84, 85, 90, 91, 92, 94, 96, 302, 328, 370, 376, 381, 394, 434, 439, 442, 444, 445, 446, 447, 484, 485, 487, 489, 490, 740 and 745.
