Division 1 Employees Raise \$300 for Diabetes in '5K Jingle Walk'



(Dec. 16, 2005) Twelve members of Central City Division 1 participated, Dec. 1, in the American Diabetes Association's "5K Jingle Walk" through downtown Los Angeles.
