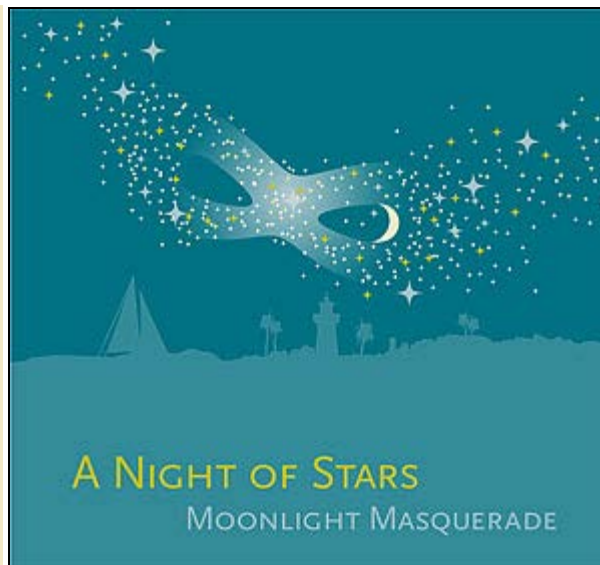

- **150 Metro Operations Employees to be Honored at 'Night of Stars'**
