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Gold Line Service to be Impacted June 9/10 for Maintenance Work

(June 7, 2007) Metro Gold Line service between Del Mar station and Mission station in Pasadena will be impacted on Saturday and Sunday, June 9 and 10, due to maintenance work.

There will be no through-train service between the two stations all day on both Saturday and Sunday. The three stations impacted by the system maintenance work are at Del Mar, Fillmore and Mission.

In support of the Pasadena's California Boulevard improvement project, Metro maintenance crews will be moving train control and grade crossing systems circuitry.

Metro will provide buses to transport patrons between the three stations. Trains will depart Union Station in downtown Los Angeles and the Sierra Madre Villa Station according to regular schedules throughout the mid-day, afternoon and evening.
