




All Train Delays (Hours) April 2017-2018






Mean Miles Between Major Failures (MMBF) April 2017-2018






Mean Miles Between Major Failures - Light Rail















Mileage Between Data Range (by month) April 2017-2018







Numbers of Major System Failures (by Line)










