ART TOWER SCULPTURE TO BE ERECTED AT MTA'S DOUGLAS STREET GREEN LINE STATION

- WHAT:** Several sculptural elements, including an 80-foot tower designed by Los Angeles artist Renee Petropoulos, will be erected and installed by crane at the MTA's future Douglas/Rosecrans Green Line station. The sculpture is reminiscent of the air ventilation shafts that appear on industrial buildings located near the station.
- WHEN:** **Wednesday, November 23, 1994**

- WHERE:** Douglas/Rosecrans Metro Green Line Station
Take Rosecrans Avenue exit off I-405 west to S. Douglas Street, turn right to station
