MTA TO HOLD THREE PUBLIC WORKSHOPS IN SAN GABRIEL VALLEY AREA TO GATHER INPUT ON BICYCLE MASTER PLAN

Bicycle planning issues will be the key focus of three public workshops to be held by the MTA to gather comments and ideas from bicyclists in the San Gabriel Valley area to help the agency formulate a Bicycle Master Plan.

MTA staff will discuss existing bicycle routes and how to improve them, where new routes should be planned, safety issues, bicycle commuting, use of rail corridors for bikeways and other bicycle-related topics.
