MTA will hold two community workshops on the Crenshaw - Prairie Transportation Corridor project. The project is a proposed 11-mile transit line planned to provide service along Crenshaw Boulevard and Prairie Avenue in the cities of Los Angeles, Inglewood, Hawthorne and the Los Angeles International Airport.

Funds have not yet been identified to construct the selected project.

The public is encouraged to attend the workshops and discuss various aspects of the proposed line including where the it should operate. Should the line go to LAX and what kind of new development will the new rail line bring to the community are issues under consideration.

MTA staff will present six alternatives for consideration, including options that focus only on bus transportation improvements for the area.
