NEW MTA COMBINED METRO TIMETABLE MAKES USING THE HARBOR TRANSITWAY QUICK AND EASY

MTA now has available a new combined Metro Bus timetable that highlights all of the MTA Metro Bus service provided via the Harbor Freeway Transitway.

The timetable shows the combined schedules of all MTA operated bus lines using the Transitway between the Artesia Transit Center on 182nd Street between Vermont and Figueroa and downtown Los Angeles including approximate times at all intermediate stations, including the Metro Green Line at the I-105 freeway.

The Harbor Freeway Transitway timetable outlines service provided by MTA's Line 444 (Palos Verdes via Hawthorne & Artesia), Line 445 (San Pedro Harbor/Beacon via I-110), Line 446 (San Pedro via Pacific & Avalon), Line 447 (San Pedro via Seventh & Avalon), and Line 550 (San Pedro via Gaffey & Vermont).

The timetable includes service provided on weekday and weekends and also includes weekday peak service provided by Line 442 (South Bay via Hawthorne & Manchester) as well as an English/Spanish fare table of the various express service currently in effect.

The new timetable was developed to show patrons how simple it is to use the service provided on the Harbor Transitway and to show the MTA service operated on the high occupancy vehicle (HOV) facility.
