- WHAT:** In preparation for new MTA fare structure scheduled to be implemented Thursday, Sept. 1, MTA announces increase in number of token sales outlets to give MTA bus and train riders throughout Los Angeles County the opportunity to purchase 90-cent discount tokens. Each 90-cent token represents a one-third discount off the new basic cash fare of \$1.35. Last month, the MTA Board of Directors voted to eliminate the regular monthly pass. The token therefore becomes the best MTA discount available.
