MTA INVITES NEIGHBORHOOD FAMILIES TO CREATE GIANT MURAL FOR VERMONT/SUNSET CONSTRUCTION SITE

Neighborhood children and their parents are invited, Sunday, Dec. 4, to help the MTA create a giant mural for the fence surrounding the Vermont/Sunset Metro Rail subway station construction site.

Artist Gayle Gale will help the amateur painters create unique designs for the 4-foot-by-eight-foot mural panels. The three-hour painting session is scheduled from 11:30 a.m. until 2:30 p.m. at Barnsdall Art Park Junior Art Center. The MTA will provide all paints, mural panels and other arts supplies. There is no charge for this event.

The "Great Metro Construction Fence Mural" will be dedicated by MTA officials at 10 a.m., Friday, Dec. 9, at the Vermont/Sunset station construction site.

The entrance to Barnsdall Art Park is located at the Metro Rail construction site, opposite the intersection of Berendo Street and Hollywood Boulevard between Vermont Avenue and Edgemont Street (Thomas Guide, 1994 Edition, Pg. 594, A-4).
