COMMUNITY INVITED TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED BUS SERVICE CHANGES TO ESTABLISH CONNECTIONS TO METRO GREEN LINE

The MTA is inviting the public to comment on proposed changes to MTA bus routes which run parallel to or cross the I-105 Freeway and lines that serve El Segundo. Changes are proposed so the buses can connect with the Metro Green Line stations when the Green Line opens in mid-1995.
