PRILUCK JOINS MTA'S METRO RAIL STAFF AS A DIRECTOR OF CONSTRUCTION

Herbert M. Priluck has joined the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority's Metro Rail construction staff as a director of construction and acting area manager.

Priluck is responsible for overseeing subway construction activity on the Hollywood/Vermont corridor, including construction of five underground stations.
