MTA, NORTHROP GRUMMAN, AND FTA TO UNVEIL FIRST "STEALTH" ADVANCED TECHNOLOGY TRANSIT BUS (ATTB)

EVENT: The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority, Northrop Grumman Corporation and the Federal Transit Administration will unveil the first prototype of the ATTB bus, a light-weight, low-floor bus manufactured with materials similar to those used in Northrop Grumman's famous B-2 Stealth Bomber. With the design assistance of transit providers from around the country, the ATTB project is expected to revolutionize the manufacturing of buses and produce the new standard transit bus for the 21st Century.
