MTA BOOSTS BUS SERVICE IN WEST LOS ANGELES

Metro bus service will increase in the West Los Angeles area this month, as a result of major changes in county-wide service, and the largest single expansion to the Metro bus fleet in 20 years

"The changes that take effect Dec. 15 will provide more efficient and more attractive service to residents in the West Los Angeles area and to the riding public in general," said MTA Chairman Larry Zarian.

On Santa Monica Boulevard, two buses will be added in the morning and two in the afternoon on Lines 4 Local and 304 Limited. Line 16, which operates on West Third Street, will get two extra buses in the morning and three in the afternoon.

Lines 33-333, operating on Venice Boulevard, will get two additional buses in the morning and two in the afternoon. The buses that run on Fairfax Avenue, Lines 1-217, will run extra trips to expand service between noon and 3 p.m.

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
